How You Can Become a Champion of Digital Citizenship in Your Classroom



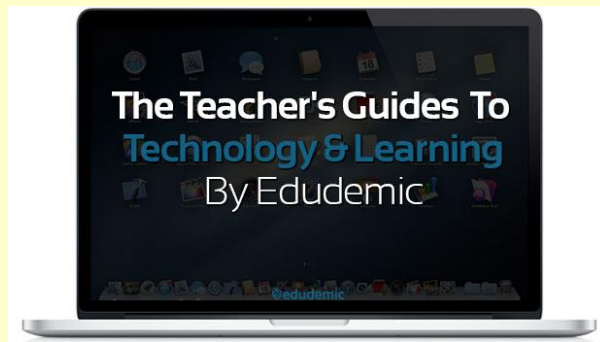
