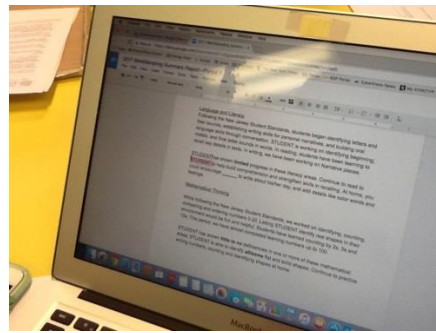
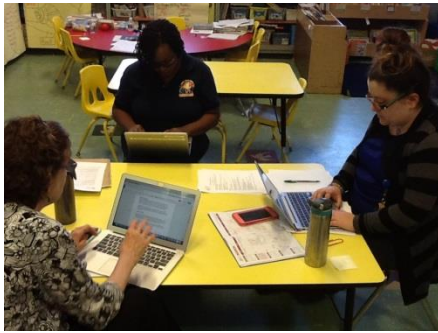


WHO TOOK A BYTE?
