About the NJGPA and Graduation

- In the spring of 2022, Grade 11 students participated for the first time in the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA) administration. This was a field test for our district.
- Governor Murphy signed P.L.2022, c.60 (ACS for A-3196/S-2349), which requires the NJGPA to be administered as a field test for grade 11 students who are expected to graduate in the class of 2023. **This law also prohibits the results of the NJGPA field test or any other assessment from being used as a prerequisite for graduation for students expected to graduate in the class of 2023.** Students in the class of 2023 must still meet all the other State and local graduation requirements, including but not limited to credit, curriculum, and attendance requirements.

About the NJGPA and Graduation

- The NJGPA measures the extent to which students are graduation ready in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics.
- The ELA component of the NJGPA assesses student graduation readiness based on grade 10 standards.
- The mathematics component of the NJGPA assesses student graduation readiness based on Algebra I and Geometry standards.

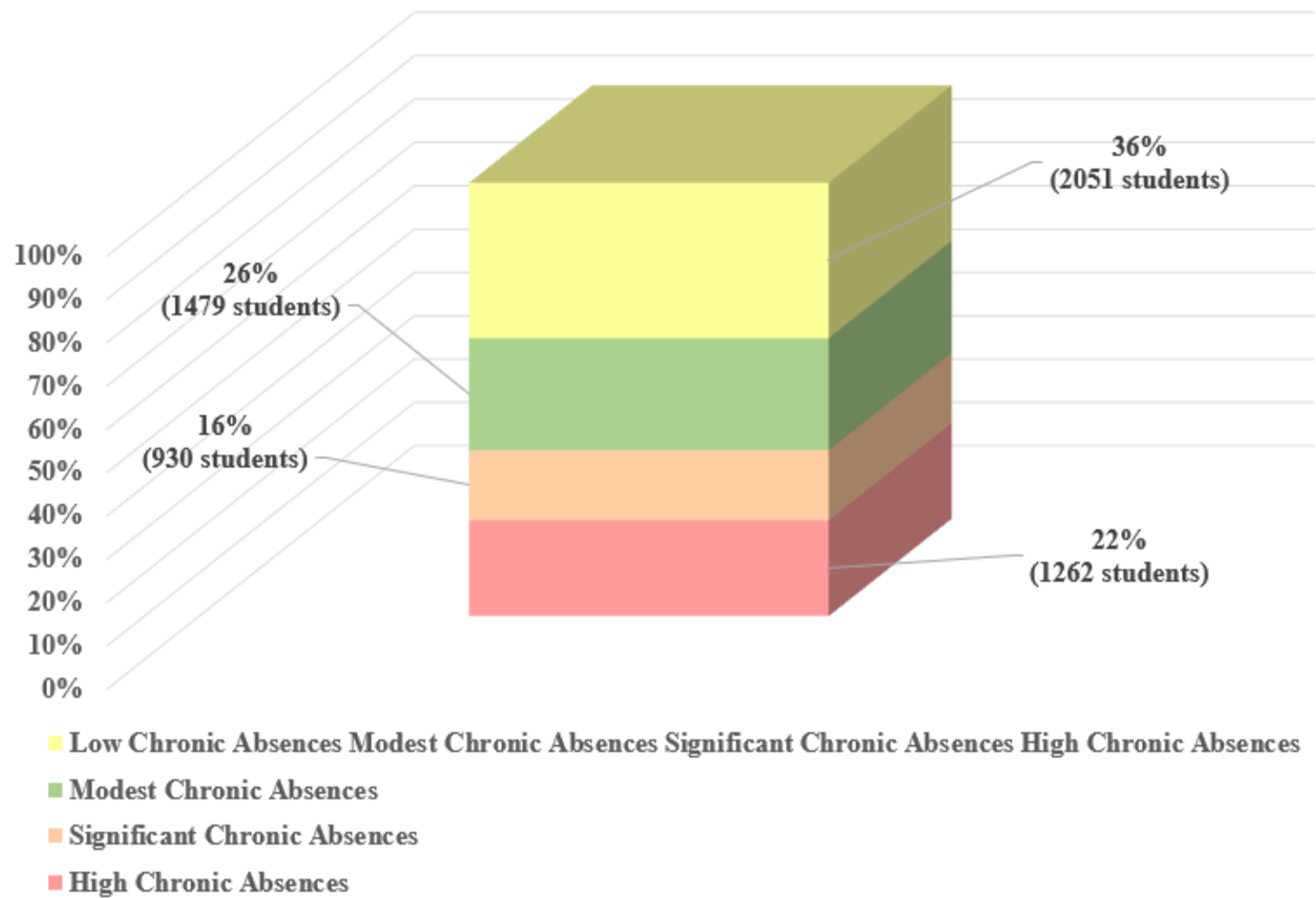

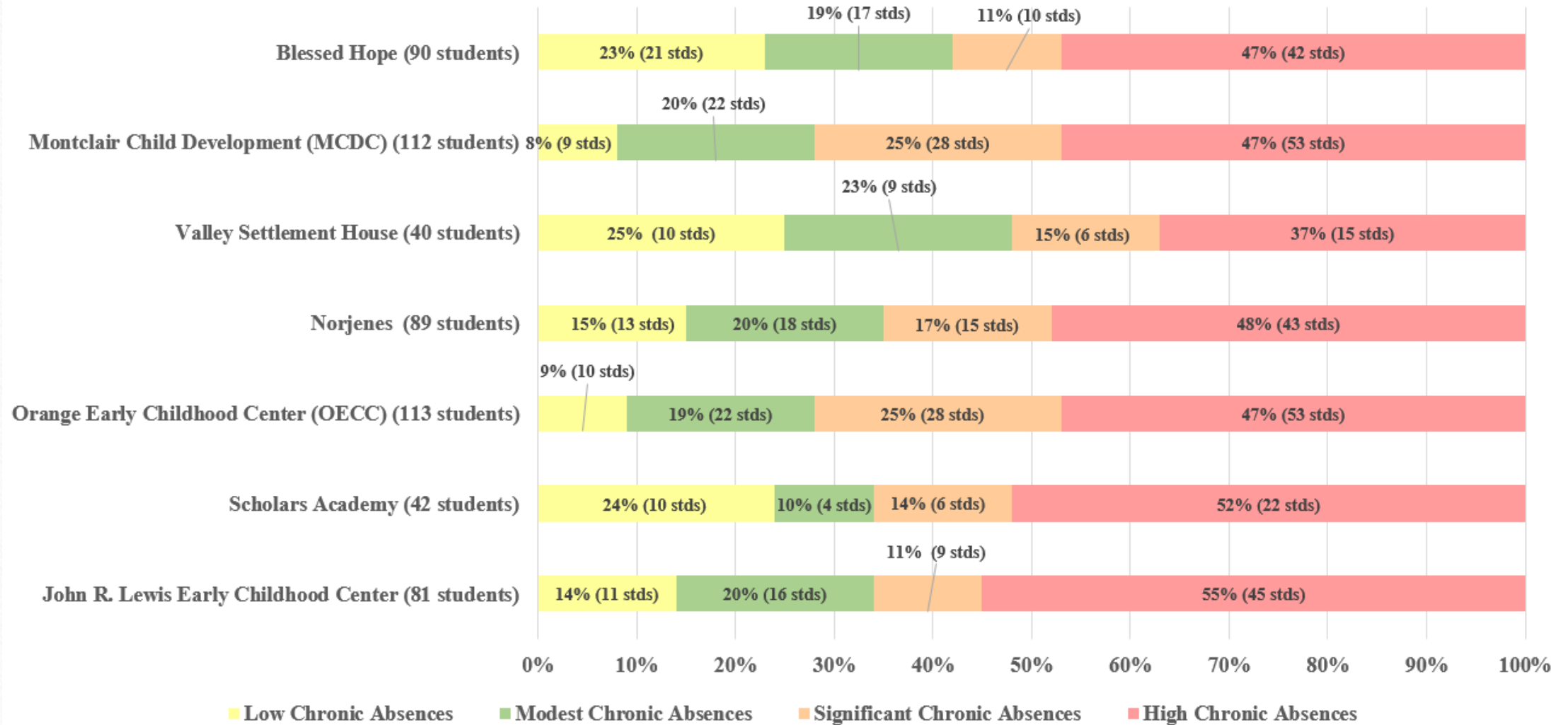

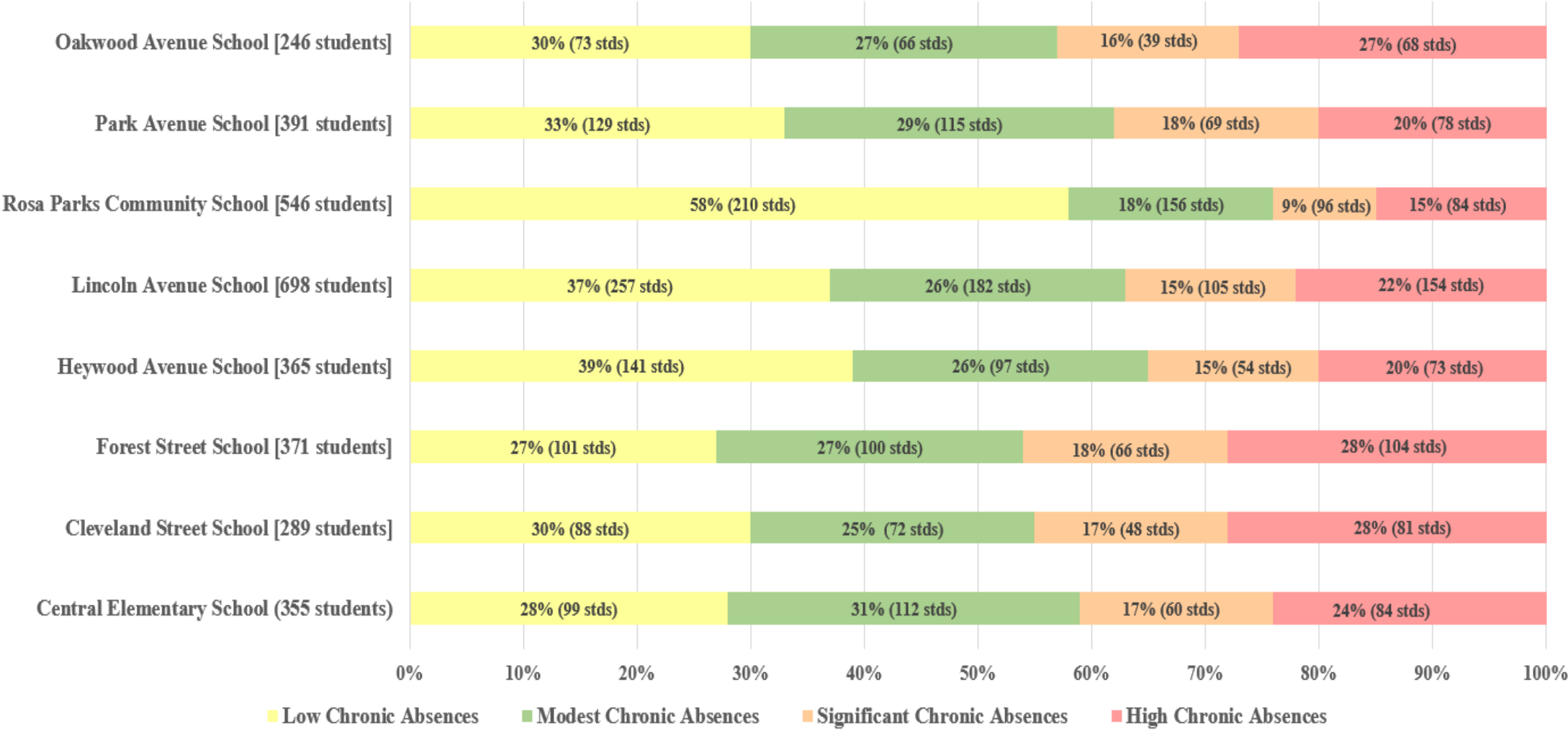
Cumulative Absences for the Month of November by Category



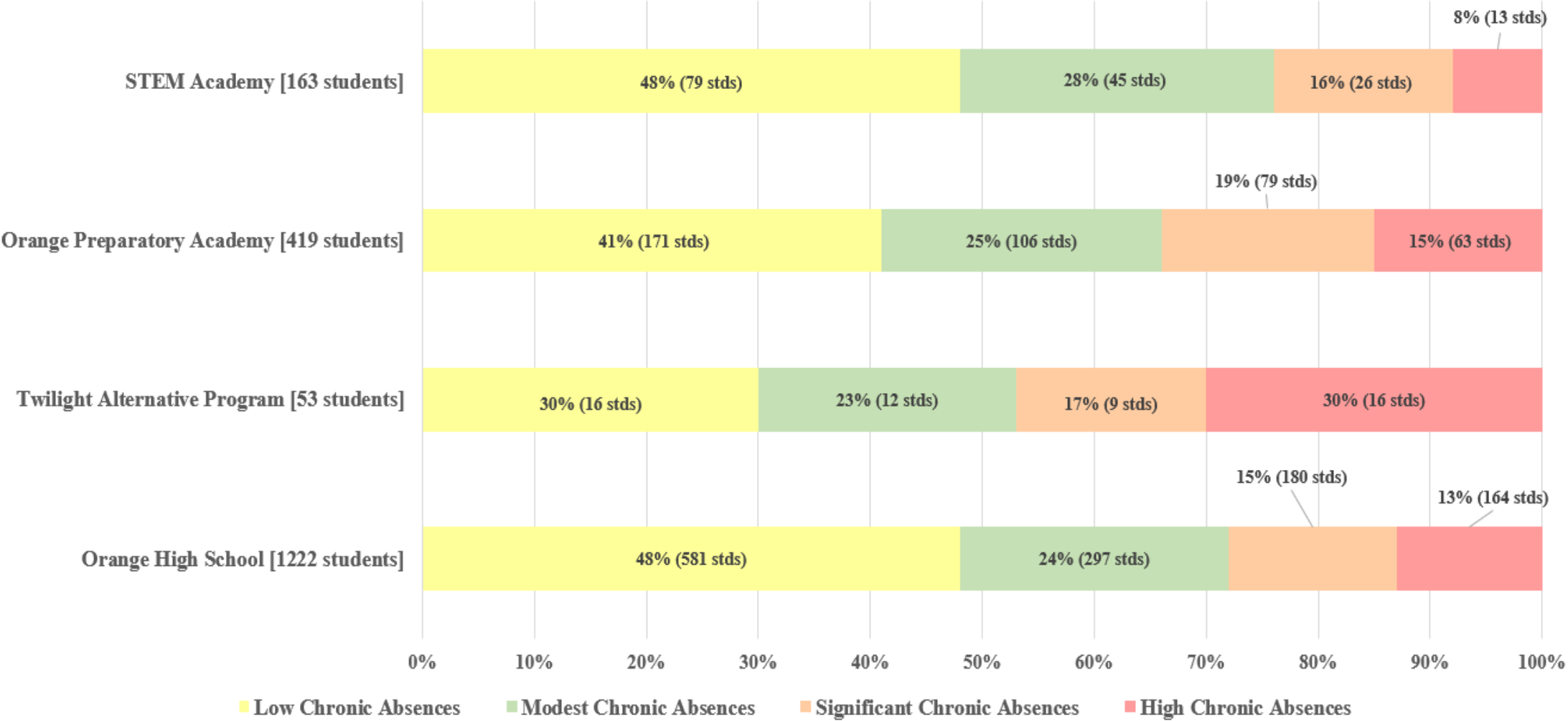
Cumulative Absences by School for the Month of November Early Childhood Program



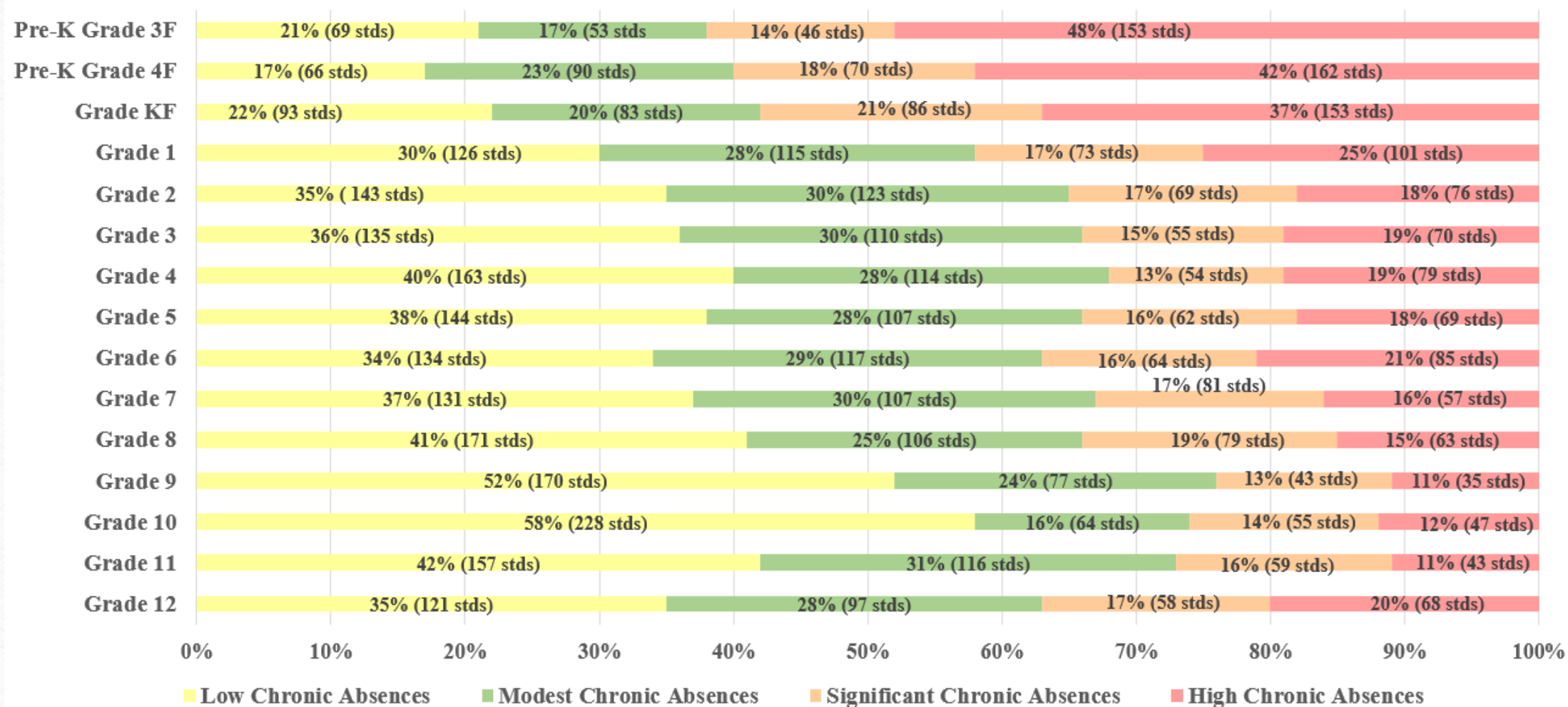
Cumulative Absences by School for the Month of November Kindergarten through Grade 7



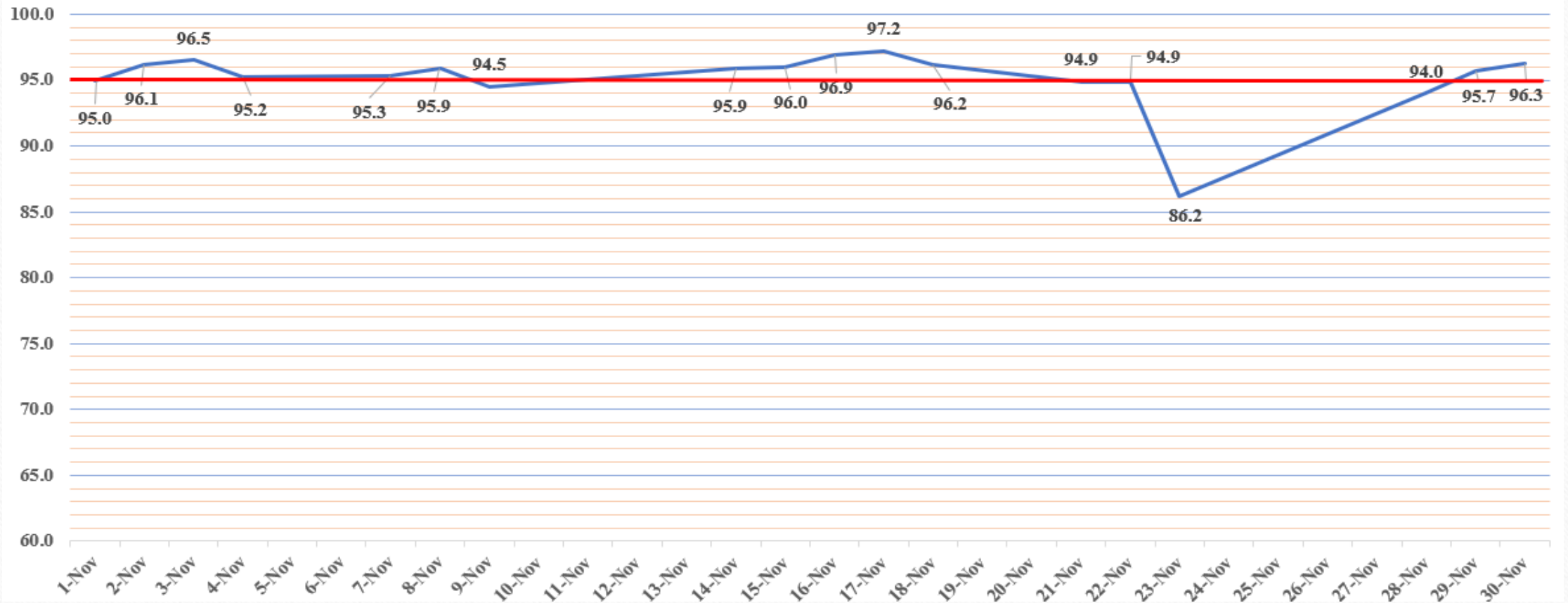
Cumulative Absences by School for the Month of November Grades 8 through 12

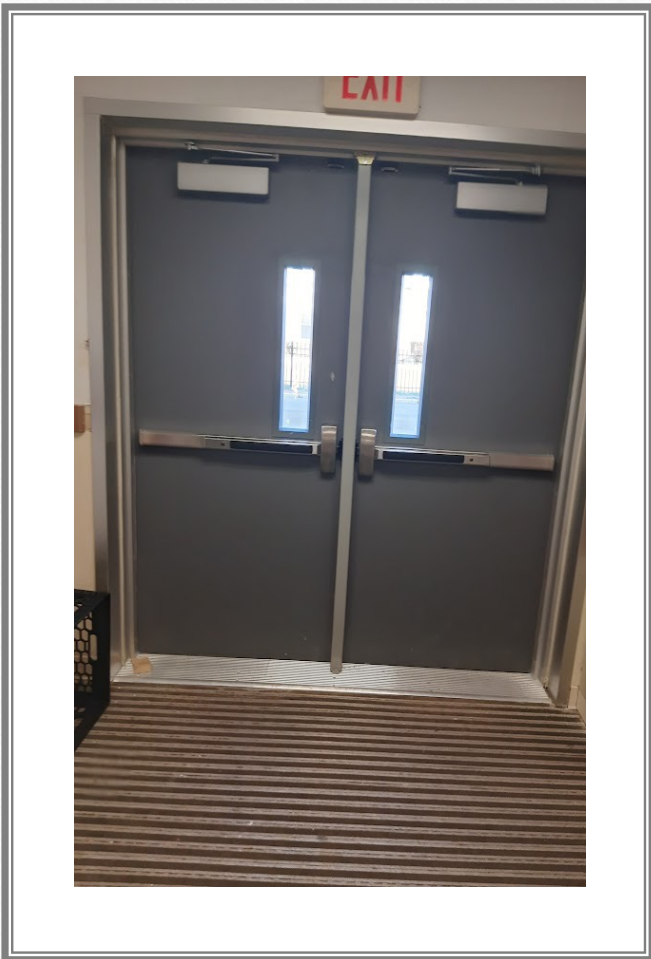
Oakwood Avenue School

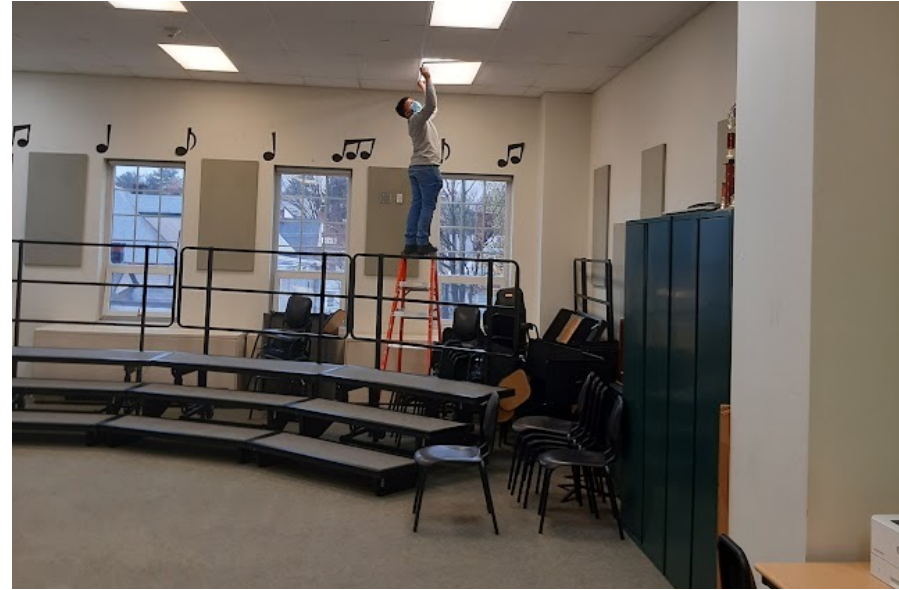

- Evaluations of curtains, blinds and shades are scheduled to take place over the next few weeks and into the new year for replacement if needed.

- The team and I will continue to meet with the Schools Development Authority and Terminal Construction to keep the district up to date with the ongoing progress at the Orange High School Renovation Project.

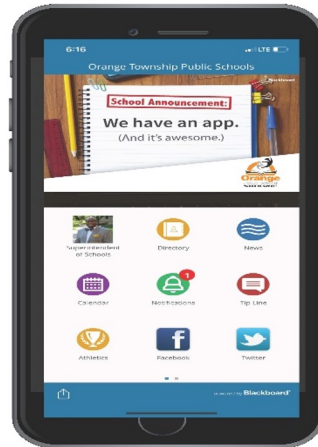
