Please be advised to ensure the continued health and safety of staff and students, the Orange Public School District have put together a staggered return to in-person learning

As we are still immersed in a pandemic; our stellar staff continue to work closely with students. In addition, teachers continue to work alongside their colleagues to ensure that the instructional scenarios presented to students are differentiated, targeted, and intentional. Through professional development opportunities and collaboration, teachers are prepared to educate our students in any scenario.
