



What is your/your children's current vaccination status?





I agree that the Universal School Mask mandate should be lifted in the coming days (staff and students will not be required to wear masks regardless of vaccination status).












Cumulative

by Category












April 2022 Average Daily Attendance Percentages *State Average is 95%
