Vision and Mission of Our Return to School Plan

Vision: Quality Learning and Superior Performance for All (including the Health and Safety of all Staff and Students as well as optimal educational experiences for the hybrid and remote students.

Mission: We prepare and inspire all learners to lead and succeed in a safe and healthy environment

Beliefs:

Trust among all stakeholders is vital.

Expectations influence accomplishments because everyone has the capacity to learn.

A school-community partnership is essential.

Change creates opportunity.

High-performing leadership makes visions reality.



Considerations: Instructional Time

- Instruction must occur 180 instructional days (as defined by the district calendar and can be in person or virtual).
- School day consists of not less than 4 hours for Grades 1-12, not less than 2.5 hours for kindergarten.
- Schedules have already been set; for those families that have opted for the hybrid model during the set timeframe, letters were sent by the school principal (individualized by student). In order to maintain the 25% of our population, we sent blasts out to register for the hybrid learning model. If open seats become available to those on the waiting list, your child's principal or their designate will contact you directly.



The Updated Plan for Phase IV

- Phase 4: April 19, 2021 June 24, 2021: All staff and students return in a hybrid setting (combining on-site and remote learning) with staggered schedules.
- *The district will continue to monitor health and safety from April 12th through the end of the year.



Considerations: Standards for Health & Safety

- Masks are required wherever social distancing cannot be accomplished
- Access to PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), hand sanitizer, partitions (if applicable) etc. As you tour the schools, this has already been solidified. PPE is available to staff and students.
- Daily Cleaning/sanitizing demands (Wednesdays will remain as the district cleaning days.) Students will remain on an asynchronous schedule where instructional and support staff will be immersed in the professional development to strengthen their craft.
- Educational Effectiveness while Social Distancing (Hybrid Teaching and Learning)
- Contingency plan for re-closure should the need arise based on health and safety parameters



Transportation Layout

- Anticipated Minimum Standards All students able to do so must wear a face covering if unable to maintain social distancing or put physical barriers between rows on bus
- CDC recommends social distancing of 6 feet or physical barriers between rows (54 student bus would go down to 11 students or 22 with barriers)
- Adopt best practices for cleaning and disinfecting buses (this discussion has already taken place with our transportation provider Essex Regional Education Services Commission)



School Level Entry and Movement



Enforce

• Enforce wearing masks and social distancing by placing tape or other markers at 6-foot intervals (All schools are outfitted in a similar fashion.)

Ensure

• Ensure that lines do not create other safety hazards. Administrators have provided multiple entrances to ensure that safety is not compromised.

Increase

• Increase number of permissible entrances while maintaining necessary security protocols (This allows for shorter lines to enter school buildings after mandatory temperature checks.

Apply

Screening protocols to other staff, parents, and visitors (Limited access to the school due to health and safety measures.)



Classroom Configuration

- Social distancing to maximum extent practical
- Requires 113 net square feet (NSF) per child, but based on spacing more likely to need 144 NSF
- Classrooms are already outfitted to maintain social distancing
- Limit sharing of items or clean between use







Training Supports for All Stakeholders: Health and Safety

- Hygiene protocols Handwashing / sanitizing throughout day (In all bathrooms as well as hallways, protocols are evident to remind staff and staff accordingly.)
- Cleaning and disinfecting protocols Between classes, equipment touched in recess periods, after sharing of items within closed cohort, other commonly touched items
- Controlling flow of traffic in building (See the attached picture.)
- Not coming to school with any symptoms (mandatory daily COVID-19 questionnaire must be filled out by all staff and students when entering the district.)





Symptoms of COVID-19

Symptoms may appear 2 -14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- **Cough**
- ➤ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- **Fatigue**
- > Muscle or body aches



Additional Symptoms of COVID-19

- > Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- ➤ Sore throat
- ➤ Congestion or runny nose
- ➤ Nausea or vomiting
- **►** Diarrhea

Special Note: All schools are outfitted with isolations rooms should students become sick during the day. The most important component is that when called, the parent/guardian must come immediately to pick up the sick child. This allows for lessening the spread of illness.

Genesis Parent Portal
