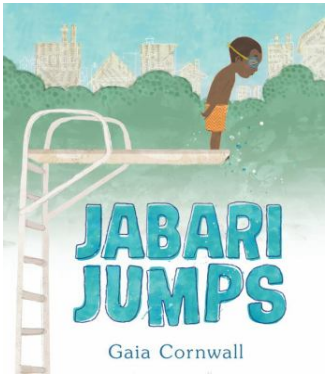


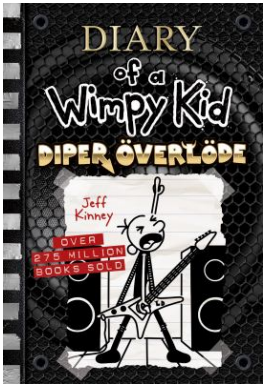
Summer Reading Suggestions

Explore and enjoy a good story this summer!



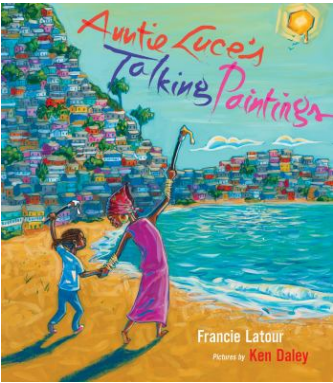
Jabari Jumps

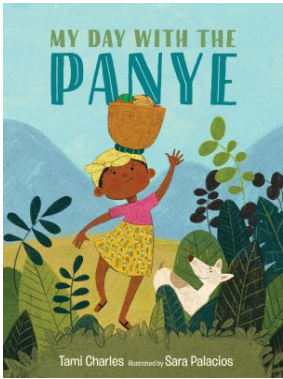
**Diary of a Wimpy Kid :

Every winter, a young girl flies to Haiti to visit her Auntie Luce, a painter. Through Haiti's colors, the girl comes to understand this place her family calls home.



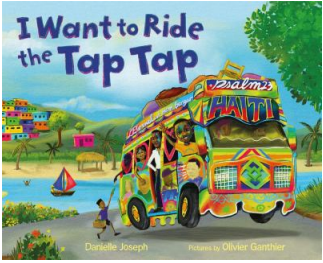
My Day with the Panyé

In the hills above Port-au-Prince, Fallon wants more than anything to carry a large woven basket to the market, just like her Manman.



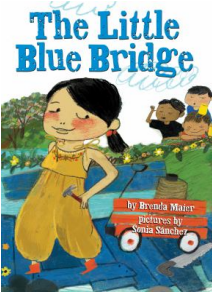
Paletero Man

Follow along with our narrator as he passes through his busy neighborhood in search of the Paletero Man.



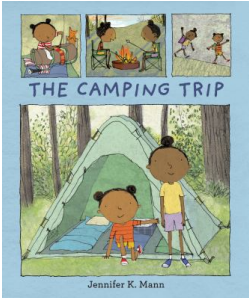
**I Want to Ride

Monday through Saturday, Claude and Manman walk Papa to the tap tap stop, where Claude meets all sorts of interesting people waiting for the tap tap.



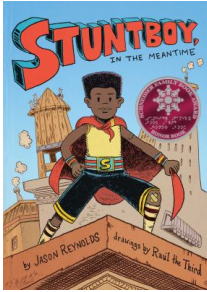
The Little Blue Bridge

Adapted from The Three Billy Goats Gruff, Ruby and her brothers want to cross a bridge to pick blueberries, but it is guarded by the bully Santiago-



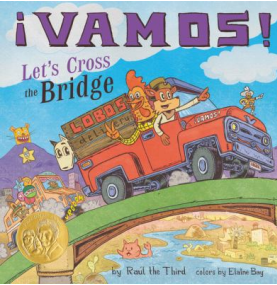
The Camping Trip

Ernestine is beyond excited to go camping. Will Ernestine be able to enjoy the wilderness, or will it prove to be a bit too far out of her comfort zone?



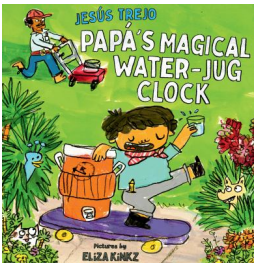
Stuntboy, in the Meantime

Little Lobo and Bernabé are bringing supplies to the big celebration in the country across the bridge -- but everyone else seems to be going, too!



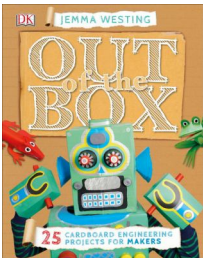

Jesús makes a big, funny mistake as he works alongside his papá.



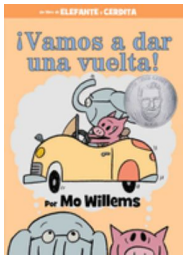

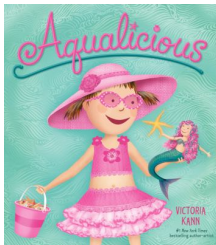

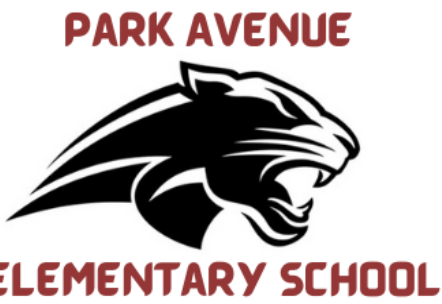
Maizy Chen's Last Chance
