

GUIDELINES

- You must be an Orange resident.
- You must be registered with a signed parent permission slip
- All registrants will register into our scheduled enrichment programs
- Sign-up is required for all trips on a first come, first serve basis with flexibility, allowing all participants an equal opportunity.
- High School students will use their student photo ID, which must be shown before participating in any activity. The City will issue IDs to 7th graders.
- Proper attire is a must — no hats on in the building, no shoes or boots on the gym floor. Pants must be pulled up.
- Anyone involved in fighting, horse play, improper conduct, wrestling, or using profanity will be asked to leave and may be subjected to suspension.
