Gifted and Talented Visitation at Scholars Academy: On May 22, 6th and 7th-grade students attending the Gifted and Talented Program at Scholars Academy finalized their projects involving three different types of turbines. They built a hydro, a vertical, and a horizontal wind turbine using Pico Solutions kits. They also redesigned blades for the horizontal turbine in Tinkercard, which their teacher Ms. Nadbielny produced on 3D printers. Students then tested and documented the results of their turbines and blade designs for their final presentations. At the end of class, each student will take home the turbine they built, the kit to continue building at home, their 3D-printed blade, and a certificate of accomplishment from Pico Systems. Superintendent Dr. Fitzhugh stopped by to see the students testing their turbines and recording the results. Learning to assemble their wind turbines, using plyers and screwdrivers, learning about the different types of turbines, and designing in Tinkercad was an excellent experience for the scholars!
