## TITLE

#### What is it?

Title I, Part A (Title I) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESEA) provides financial assistance to local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools with high numbers or high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards.

### How does it help students?

Schools in which children from lowincome families make up at least 40
percent of enrollment are eligible to
use Title I funds to operate schoolwide
programs that serve all children in the
school in order to raise the
achievement of the lowest-achieving
students.

#### SMART GOAL 1

By June 2024 at least 65%-70% of students in grades 3-7 will meet or exceed the projected growth as measured by the HMH Student Growth Measure.

#### INTERIM GOALS

NOV. 15: By EOC 1, 100% of students will complete baseline HMH Growth Measure to determine lexile level and set goals for each individual students.

FEB. 15: By EOC 2, at least 25-30% of students in grades K-7 will meet their first cycle Growth Measure Goals based on goals set in September 2023

APR. 15: By EOC 3, at least 45–55% of students on grades K-7 will meet their first cycle Growth Measure Goals based based on goals set in September 2023.

#### SMART GOAL 2

By June 2024 at least 65–70% of students in grades K – 7 will meet their projected growth goal as measured by iReady.

#### INTERIM GOALS

NOV 15: By the EOC 1 – 100% of students K-7 will complete baseline using the iReady diagnostic to determine growth target.

<u>FEB 15</u>: By the EOC 2, at least 35% of students in grades K-7 will meet their mid year projected growth targets.

APR 15: By the EOC 3, at least 50% of students in grades K-7 will meet their projected growth targets.

#### SMART GOAL 3

By June of 2024 there will be a 60% increase in student proficiency on the Science benchmark assessment.

#### INTERIM GOALS

NOV 15: By the EOC 1, 100% of students 3–7 will complete baseline using the Science diagnostic.

<u>FEB 15</u>: By the EOC 2, at least 20% of students in grades 3–7 will demonstrate proficiency on the 2nd benchmark assessment.

APR 15: By the EOC 3, at least 40% of students in grades 3–7 will demonstrate proficiency on the 3rd benchmark assessment.

#### SMART GOAL 4


By June 2024, we will increase the amount of self-reflection in classrooms to 60% as measured via lesson plans, walkthrough data and student surveys.


#### INTERIM GOALS

NOV 15: 100% of students will receive an overview on SEL with a focus on Self Reflection. Students will complete a fall survey on SEL and self-reflection.

<u>FEB 15</u>: 30% of students will be exposed to and participate in 2 SEL self-reflection activities.

APR 15: 45% of students will be exposed to and participate in 2 additional SEL self-reflection activities.








