I. Interventions:

- a. Math 180 – students in grades 5-7 continue to use program on Thursday's and Friday's. There have been some improvements. Math teacher has looked at correlation between Math 180, NWEA and prior PARCC test results.
- b. iRead – Students are showing a lot of growth. All of Kindergarten on grade level. Most first graders on grade level- teacher using groupinator. Second grade is showing growth, struggling students have been referred to I&RS. Two students on target to move out of iRead
- c. After school tutoring – teachers collaborate with day time teachers for information regarding skills that need to be reviewed with students.
- d. Paraprofessionals must be used as instructional aids and part of lesson plans
- e. CPT meetings used to discuss data and best practices.
- f. Americorp workers – are strategically placed in classrooms to provide assistance in small group instruction.
