Dear Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers,

We are so excited for the start of the 2024-2025 school year at the John Robert Lewis Early Childhood Center (JRLECC)! Welcome back to our returning families and welcome to our new families. The JRLECC staff is anxiously awaiting our partners (You!) to develop and educate our young scholars. Our teachers and staff began training in our new curriculum, *Creative Curriculum*, in June and will continue to train and prepare for the children's meaningful learning experiences. MORNING ENTRANCE PROCEDURES

Students must arrive at school by 8:30 a.m. We need our students to be on time and present every day.

- There will be no entry prior to 8:30 a.m. as teachers and staff are preparing to welcome the children.
- Parents/caregivers should bring their children to their classroom, where they will sign them in.
- Breakfast will be served and eaten in the classroom when the children arrive.



DISMSSAL PROCEDURES

- All students are *dismissed at 3:00 p.m.* They will be dismissed from the same door where they entered in the morning.
- If you are unable to pick up your child on a certain day, please provide prompt written notification to the Main Office. Include the name of the person who will be picking them up and include their phone number. This person will need to show identification before signing the child out. Your child's teachers will also be informed.
- It is especially important that the Emergency Form is immediately updated if there are any changes during the school year.

. <u>ST UDENT ATTIRE</u> Students should dress appropriately for a school setting. The following items of clothing are inappropriate and are not to be worn to school:

- Blouses or sweaters that show a bare midriff, halter tops, bandanas, tank tops, tops with thin straps, short shorts, short miniskirts, clinging, or form fitting spandex leggings (without the appropriate length skorts, shorts, skirt, or dress), pants/jeans worn below the waist, and pants/jeans with rips 4" above the knee (including any rip that shows through to skin, undergarments, or fabric.). All flannel-type pants and sleepwear are not permitted.
- Appropriate and safe footwear must be always worn. Specifically, no flip-flops or "sliders" are to be worn due to the safety factor when walking and/or playing. All sandals must be secured at the toes and ankle for safety.

<u>FORMS:</u> Students will receive the emergency contact form on the first day of school. Please review and complete the emergency form and other corresponding forms and return them to your child's teacher as soon as possible. It is very important to update this form if there are any changes during the school year. Please let us know if you need any assistance.

Norjene's Day Care Center offers before and aftercare services for in-district preschoolers. Before and aftercare hours are 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Childcare vouchers are accepted.
