Caught Up in Learning...

During the month of October we were brimming with creativity and participated in many exciting learning experiences. The Orange Fire Department visited our school and taught us all about staying safe and what to do if there is a fire. (NJS: Health and Safety and Physical Education).

We visited Alstede Farms where we took a hay ride through the apple orchards and picked pumpkin from the pumpkin patch and enjoyed apple cider. (NJS: Social Studies, Science, English language Arts & Math)



We predicted what we will find inside a pumpkin, measured our pumpkins, and looked at the inside of the pumpkin. We made an apple tree, apple sauce, tasted different variety of apples and worked together to create an apple orchard. We explored mixing fall colors using eyedroppers, and even had the opportunity to sort and examine pumpkins seeds, apple seeds and leaves, acorns and pinecones under the magnifying glass. (NJS: Science) We did a puppet show "Tucker Turtle," who helped remind us what to do when we have a problem and how to find solutions to help us solve our problems. (NJS: Social Emotional Development)
