PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Jeffrey Feld (Local Businessman) commends the group about the referendum signed. He mentioned that his comments at the July 11, 2017 meeting were not recorded. He also referred to his OPRA request regarding records of the acquisition of the MaryLawn building and about how the \$2.5m bond is being used. He said that he is entitled to a response to his request. Mr. Hunt responded, stating that his responses were sent regarding the OPRA request.
- Gloria Stewart (citizen of Orange) said as an advocate of public education, she favored an elected board and expressed disappointment at the nullification of the votes to transfer to an elected board. She requested an explanation for the meaning of STEM. She also wants to know how it will benefit students K-12 in the District. Mr. Lee addressed her concerns, explaining the meaning of STEM and provided some background info relating the shift towards STEM. He explained some of the reasons for starting STEM and the benefits of the program. She also expressed disappointment in the new hires stating that no Orange graduate is part of the group.
- Peter Lemon wants to know why the STEM school is not cited in Orange, instead of locating it in South Orange. Mr. Lee responded to his questions, stating that the District was not able to get a building within town for the program. Mr. Lee said in view of growing enrollment, there is a plan for other expansion.
