BOARD MINUTES

October 8, 2019 - Closed Meeting October 8, 2019 - Public Meeting

BOARD COMMENTS

- Roll Call was performed by Mr. James at 7:40pm followed by the Flag Salute.
- Dr. Fitzhugh II rendered the Superintendent's Report, giving updates on what has been happening District-wide in the instruction and curriculum areas. He referred to how info is being disseminated over social media. He commended Ms. Sacks for the Teen Summit she has been organizing for the kids. Slides on the Teen Summit were rendered. He reported on Professional Development Day on October 14, 2019 and October 29, 2019 with a 93% attendance rate. Principals, Vice Principals, Supervisors and the superintendent were involved in the PD exercise. The content of the PD included lesson planning, design, behavioral strategies, etc. He commended Ms. Purkiss for her efforts on the enhancement and additions to the District website as well as the tech coordinators.
- Dr. Fitzhugh also reported on the schedules for the second Board Meeting of the month, stating that detailed schedules are on the website. He explained November's instructional focus will be adaptive leadership. It includes observations, interpretations, interventions, etc. He stated that walkthroughs are performed district-wide to ensure instructional pedagogy is happening, stressing that it is not punitive but to make teachers perform better.
- Dr. Fitzhugh gave updates on Pre-Kindergarten classrooms in district schools and on Special Education programs district-wide to let people know where these programs are available in the District.
- Ms. Harper rendered a presentation on Dynamic Learning Maps (an assessment used for students who are cognitively impaired). It helps students and parents as well.
- Dr. Russo rendered the ACCESS assessment results presentation. (ACCESS is given to students in ESL/Bilingual. The test is mandated by the State of New Jersey.
- Ms. Dismuke reported on staff vacancies in the District.
- Dr. Fitzhugh shared with the community the attendance report by categories in October 2019. Also the monthly tardiness report.
- A motion was moved to go back into executive session.
- 2nd Public Session opened at 9:12 with roll call by Mr. James.
- Mr. Sherif expressed satisfaction on providing additional police officers and other efforts made by OPD in hiring more crossing guards.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

• Ms. Williams, whose daughter attends OPA, complained that one of her teachers left and would like to know if the teacher will be replaced and when.

- Ms. Karen Blair said her son goes to Heywood and that her child was picked up by an unauthorized person. She wants to know what type of security, police, cameras, etc. are used to keep kids safe. She wants an immediate solution to the problem. Dr. Fitzhugh said the administration has put in lots f security and that Heywood has a stringent security system, with the Principal, VP and security officers effectively working on security.
- Mr. Christopher Walker, 646 Lincoln Avenue, wants to know if there is any after school program and would like to contribute to the District.
- Mr. Wayne expressed appreciation for vacancies being filled. He wants to know about enrollment at STEM, whether kids from other towns can attend and Dr. Fitzhugh addressed his concerns. Mr. Carter also explained to him that Orange students filled all available slots. He commended the Superintendent for having dialogue and expressed satisfaction on student achievement.
- Ms. Gloria Stewart said that she has difficulty about the Public Meeting and changes to the prior arrangement. She also said that the opportunity at STEM for students from other towns will come up. She thanked Mr. James for lights at Heywood Ave School. She poke on the crossing guard situation and would like more crossing guards instead of police officers. She also commented on the safety & security situation at Heywood, saying it needs improvement. She briefly expressed satisfaction on the outcome of the election (elected board). She also spoke on staff vacancies and would like the District to find ways to keep teachers.
- Ms. Rita wanted to know what is going on with breakfast, that they are not good.
 She wants improvement in the food served to students.
- Mr. Allen commended Dr. Fitzhugh for what is going on in the District, stating that many people are talking about the great things being done in the District from teachers, community and other stakeholders.
