# **BOARD COMMENTS**

- Roll Call was performed by Mr. James at 7:15pm followed by a short presentation by Steve Edelstein from the law firm of Schwartz, Simon, Edelstein & Celso, LLC
- The legal firm representative (Steve) explained the case and certain issues considered by the Judge in reaching a decision to nullify the result of the March 28, 2017 election (changing the District to Type II). Additionally, he said the Judge ruled that the bond earlier approved by the Board of School Estimates be reinstated and that the District can now proceed with the \$2.5 million bond.

# PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Tyrone Tarver asked when the conference call occurred relating to the bond issue.
- Patricia Arthur expressed happiness that the case was won in the interest of the children of Orange. The \$2.5 million bond will go a long way in fixing the facilities issues. She said there is no reason why the City and the board should not work together in the interest of the children.
- Tyrone Tarver referred back to the January 10<sup>th</sup> issues when the attorney was hired and bond issue discussed. He referred to the Agenda relating to an aspect where job descriptions were revised. Ms. Smiley addressed his concerns.
- Mr. Copeland explained the bond issue to Mr. Tarver in terms of amount and how it was put together.
- The Board Attorney (Mr. Hunt) explained to the public and board members the timeframe of when to expect the bond to be completed and when the District will receive the funds. He specifically said that if everything goes normally, the District should expect the bond money before the end of June 2017. He mentioned that the bond will be floated along with the City of Orange bond of about \$2.2 million proposed for certain expenditures.
- The City of Orange Business Administrator (Christopher Hartwyk) also explained to the board that necessary process will be set in motion and the bond should be finalized by the middle of June 2017.
