BOARD MINUTES

September 13, 2016 - Special Closed Meeting September 13, 2016 - Special Public Meeting

BOARD COMMENTS

- Roll call was performed by Mr. James at 7:08pm. The Flag Salute was performed by students of Rosa Parks Community School. Awards and recognition were given to Students and Parents of the Month followed by a presentation on PARCC results by Dr. Russo. A presentation was also rendered on the Male Mentoring Program by Mr. Reggie Miller. Ms. Shelly Harper also rendered the HIB presentation.
- Mr. Lee reported that this month is Breast Cancer Awareness Month and that fund raising will take place.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Gloria Stewart expressed thanks to board members for changing the start of Public Session to 7:00pm. She also thanked Mr. Miller for his program. She asked about the Heywood Avenue School playground, the status of the project and when would it be completed. Mr. James responded to her concerns that the Bond Council is yet to approve the bond. She also wanted to know the Superintendent's contract status. Ms. Mateo said the contract is under review.
- Kofi Allen said he is the father of a six year old at Heywood Avenue School and expressed concerns about what is being taught at the school. He said the homework they give his son is substandard to what they give in some public charter schools in Newark. He said the Orange School District is robbing the children of Orange. Mr. Lee responded to his concerns.
- Mr. Dwight Holmes said that the success of Newark Public Charter Schools is that
 they use a lottery to enroll kids and would like to invite Kofi Allen to join the
 P.T.O. and also parents should partner with the school district. He wants to know
 why the District did not observe the Columbus Day holiday. He also suggested
 that vacation days of teachers/staff should be reduced to increase instructional
 hours. Mr. Lee addressed his concerns
- Ms. Patricia Arthur said the Board should rescind what they did in July, since they
 have agreed to extend the Superintendent's contract. She said there should be a
 resolution to rescind the action taken in July. Mr. Hunt read the letter relating to
 Mr. Lee's contract.

- Jeremy Gravensame, parent of students in the District, said he is only concerned
 with what the District is doing, not what the state is doing. He wants to see that
 students of orange are performing above average. He wants to know the Teacher
 turnover rate in the district. He suggested making a phone blast to the Public for
 board meetings to increase attendance.
- Tyrone Tarver stated that the school district is underperforming. He would like some clarification whether any board member has children going to school in the District. Mr. Carter responded that the fact that board members' children are not going to school in the District doesn't mean that they are no dedicated and not doing their best in educating the kids. He referred him to increased graduation rates and student achievement.
