BOARD COMMENTS

PUBLIC COMMENTS

She expressed appreciation for the Orange Education Association for grants coming in through them. She would also like to show appreciation to the students of Park Ave and Heywood Ave Schools. She also thanked Dr. Howard for all she is doing District-Wide in terms of the education of our students.
- Bill Nussbaum, President of Orange Education Association, expressed satisfaction at the recognition being bestowed on staff and students in the District, particularly during the Superintendent's Forum, achievements of Staff. He complained that the Teacher's Guide needs to be agreed upon because he feels salaries are going down.
- Staff of Orange complained about low pay, stating that staff are leaving because of the low salaries. He complained that he has been in the District for 9 years with only a \$2,000 dollar increase over the years, questioning how does the District intend to attract and retain good staff?
- An OHS English Teacher complained about the low pay in the Orange School District. She also said there is a need to support teachers.
- Mr. Lee addressed their concerns, stating that the State's funding is the reason for low pay in the District.
