Finance Committee:

 Cuts are around \$4 million. We were already underfunded now the budget cuts are causing a greater impact.
- The outstanding school transportation expense is still under discussion.
 Title 18A states do not pay until service is rendered. The
 Superintendents roundtable is still discussing the matter.
- Mr. Tarver noted that committee reports should be submitted the Friday before the monthly board meeting to give each member a chance to review.
- Ms. Johnson thanked Dr. Fitzhugh for his hard work as well as the administration, and Mr. James. Mr. Wingfield agreed.
- Mr. Sherif asked Mr. Tarver to refrain from commenting after everyone's comment. He asked Mr. Tarver to save his comments for last since he is the board president. Mr. Tarver responded that sometimes he has to cut comments during the closed meeting so they can close out on-time for the public meeting. He noted that if they do not start by 8 pm, we have to cancel the meeting.
- Mr. Tarver requested a meeting on Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at 5 pm, also a Special Closed meeting at 6:30 pm, and the Public meeting to follow at 7:30 pm.
 Everyone commented that they are available except Ms. Mateo said she is unsure.
- Mr. Tarver requested a Closed meeting Friday, June 26, 2020 at 5 pm to discuss a confidential matter. Everyone commented that they are available except Ms.
