- Joel Torres expressed concerns with the underfunding by the State. He is willing
 to join forces to go and protest in Trenton. He said he works on substance abuse

 also like to partner with the District to bring more resources on Substance Abuse.
- Kevin Cushing expressed concerns that the District will continue to lose experienced teachers, stating that the District should value experience and try to retain experienced teachers.
