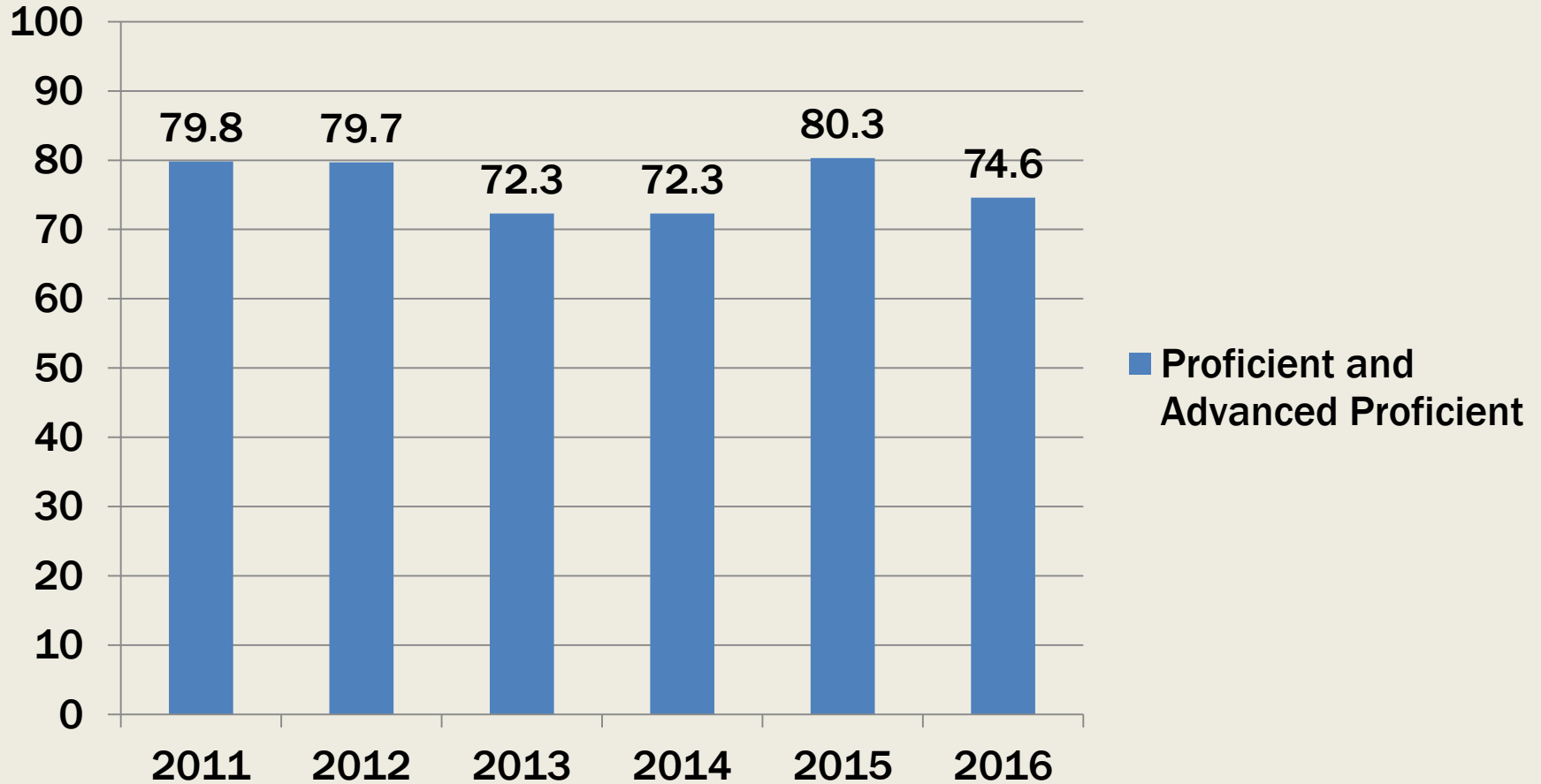

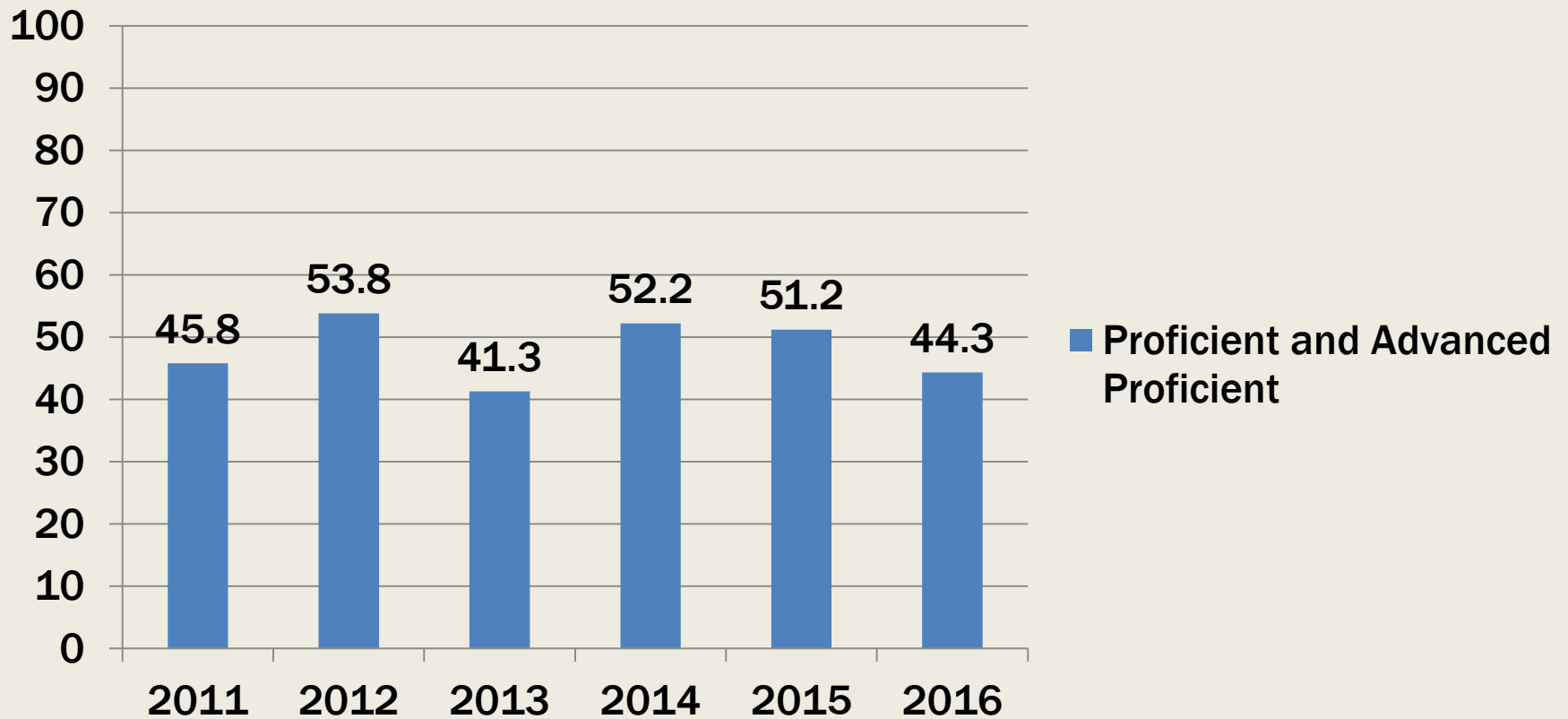

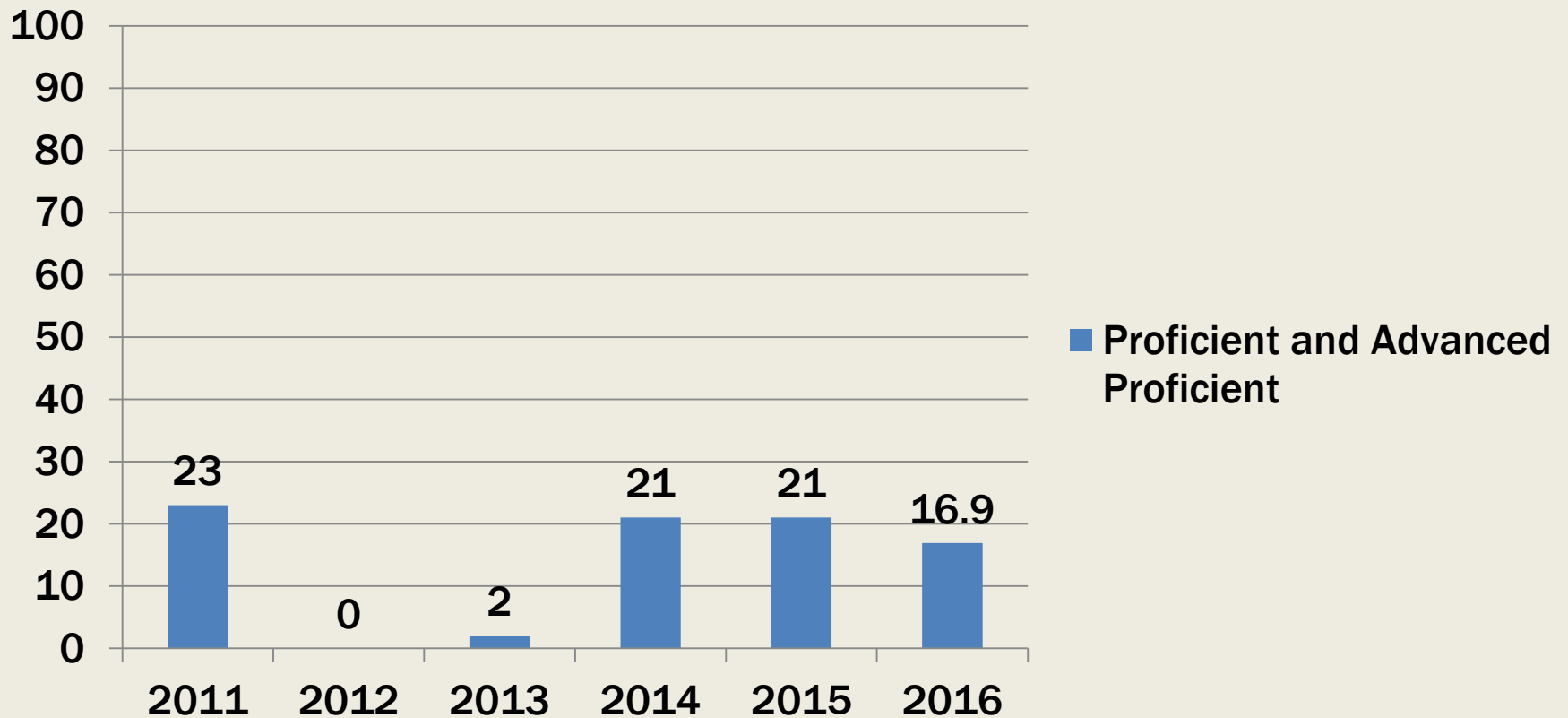
GRADE 8 NJASK

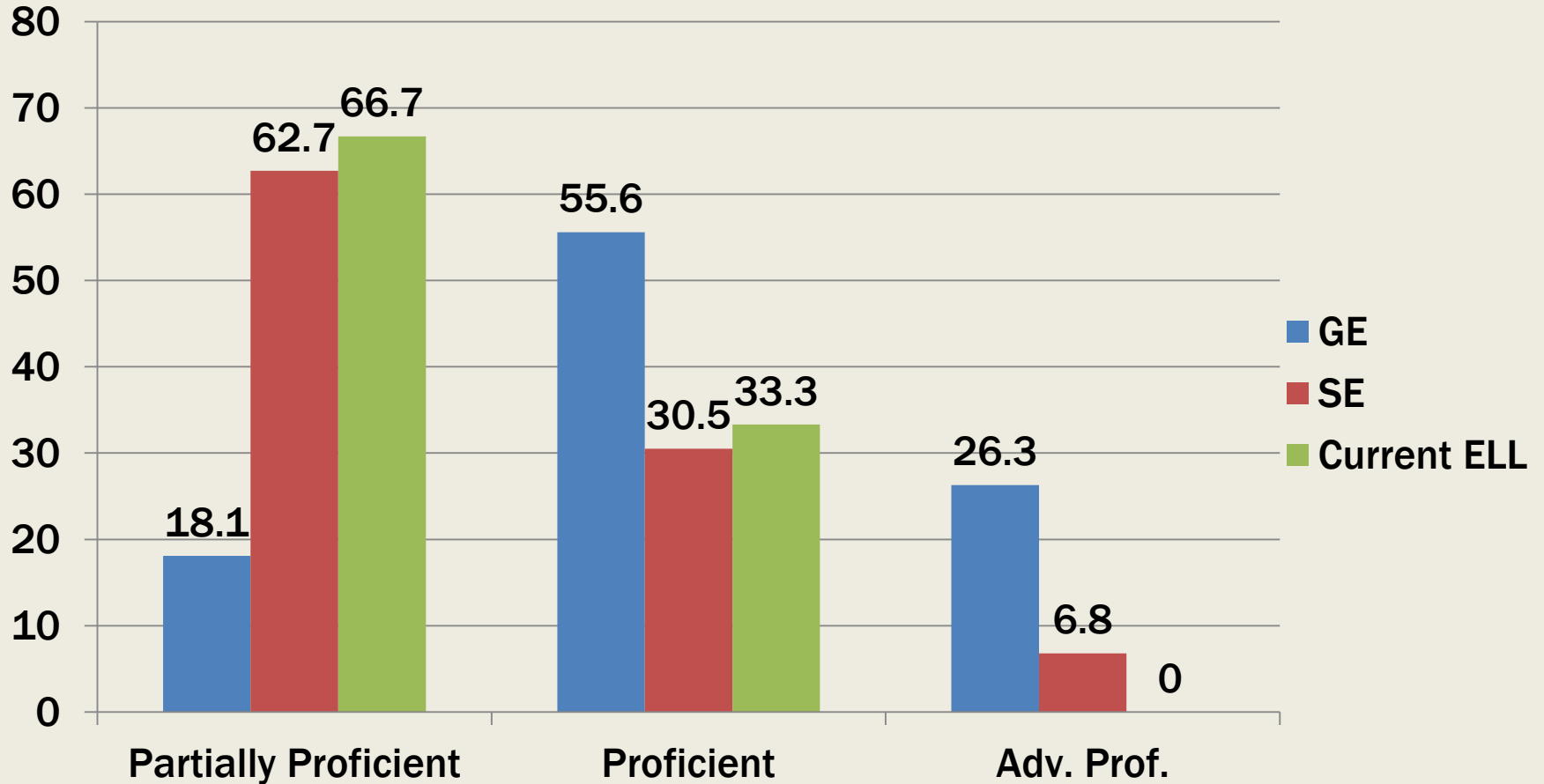


BIOLOGY END-OF-COURSE ASSESSMENT

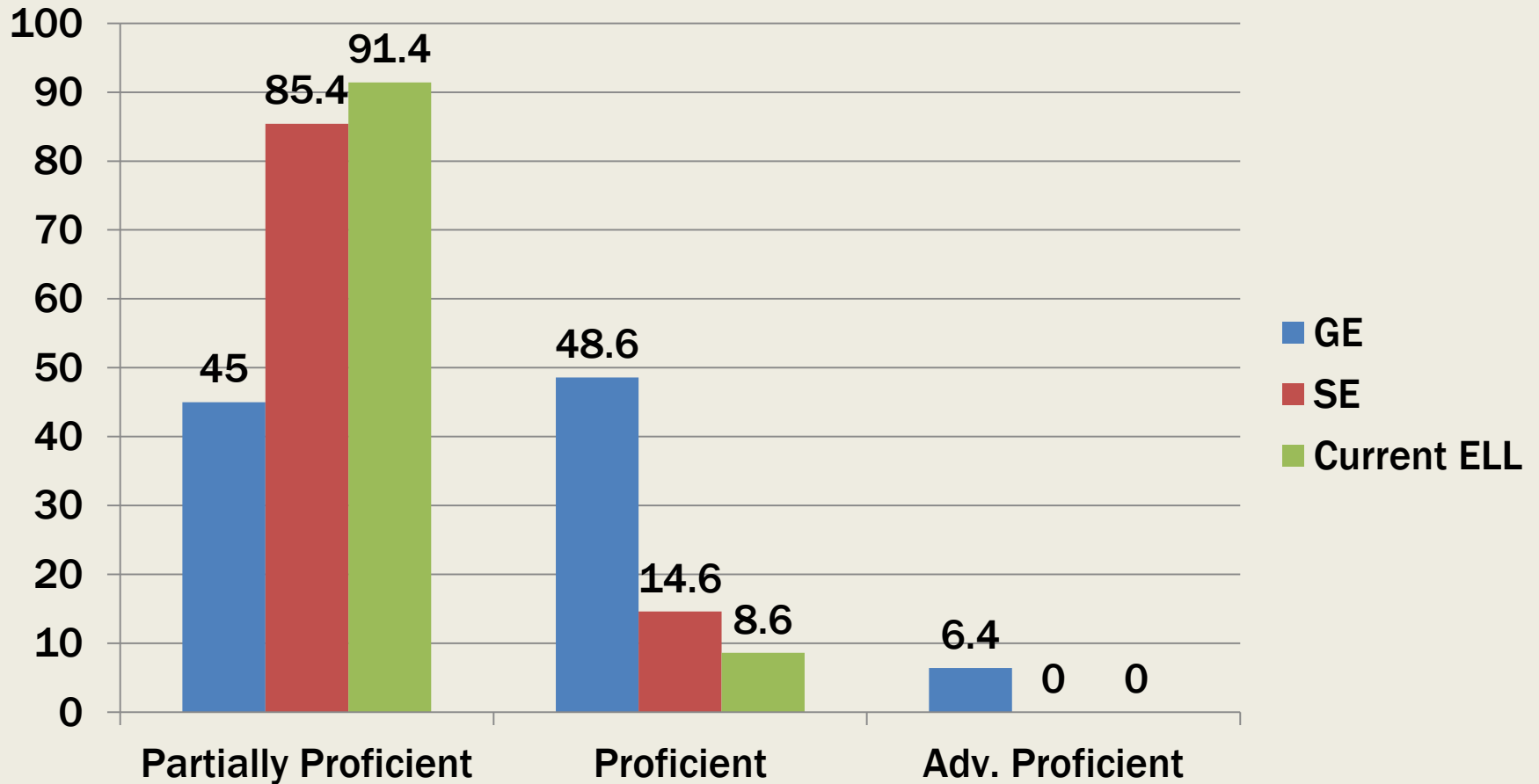

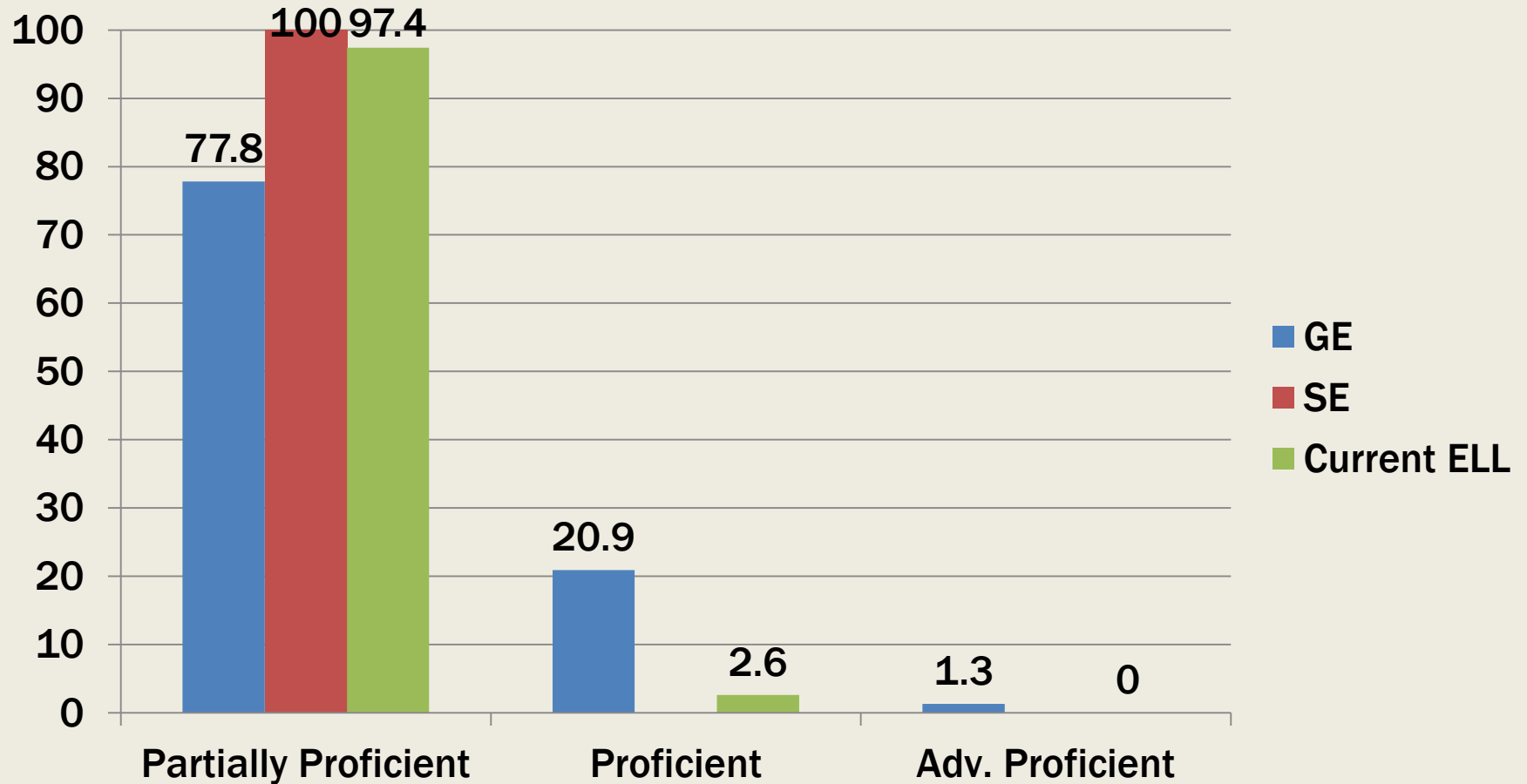
2016 GRADE 4 SCIENCE DISAGGREGATED RESULTS



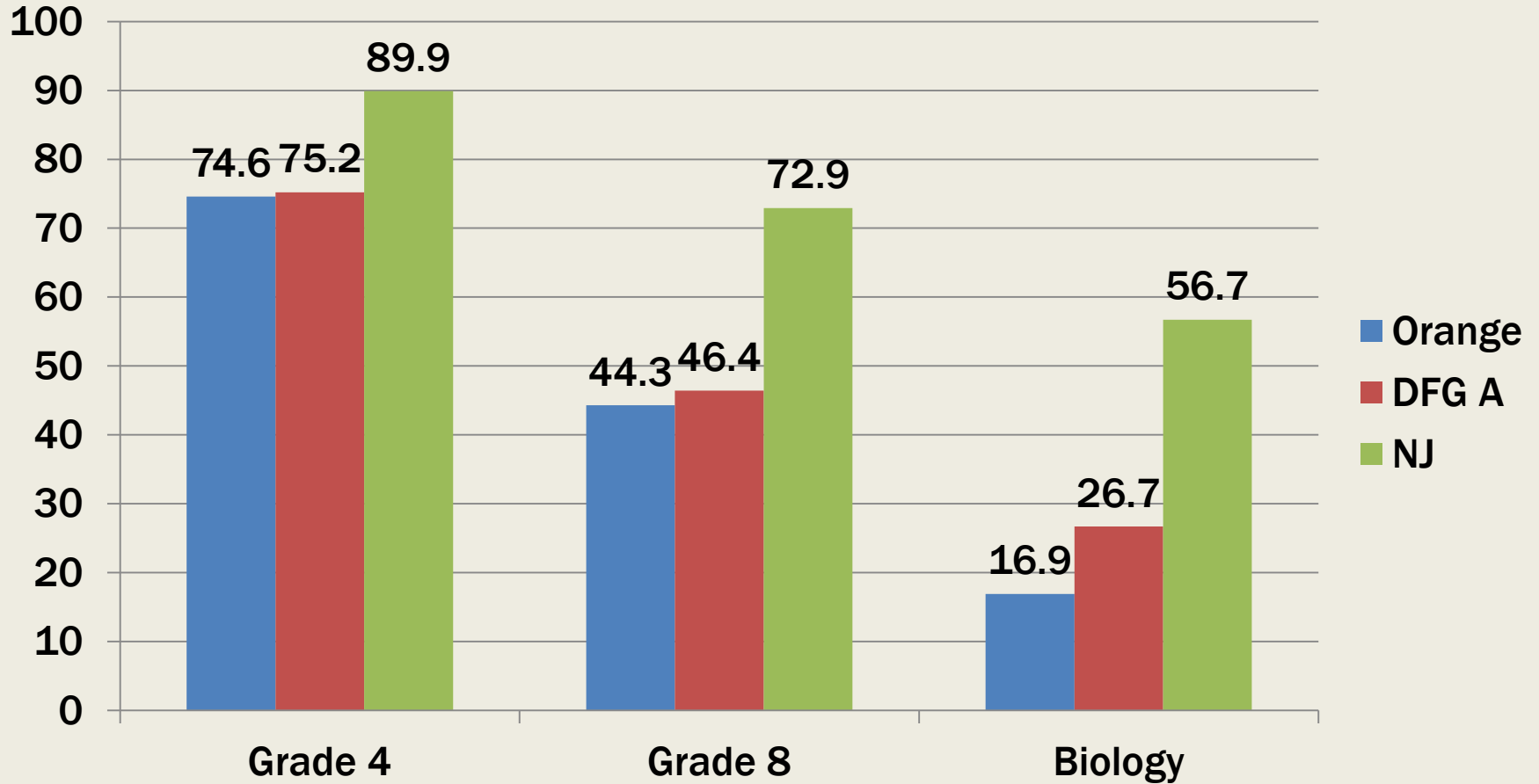
2016 GRADE 8 SCIENCE DISAGGREGATED RESULTS
