Orange High School Community Service Requirement

Students at all grade levels are encouraged and motivated to engage in an extensive volunteer program providing assistance, lending their talents, skills, time, energy, and positive attitudes to a diverse community population. In addition to academic requirements, community service is a prerequisite for graduation.

Requirements:

- 1. Every student of Orange High School* must participate in 15 hours of community service each school year.
- 2. At the conclusion of their senior year, all Orange High School students must fulfill 60 hours of community service for graduation.
- 3. New students will be required to complete 15 hours for each year that they are registered at Orange High School.
- 4. Service activities include:
 - a. Mentorship
 - b. Tutoring
 - c. Non-profit organizations
 - d. Religious and non-secular organizations
 - e. OHS Community centered events
 - f. School based activities may only compromise 20% of the required hours. Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 5. Service may not be done for family members or financial gain.
- 6. The OHS Community Service Commitment Form must be completed in its entirety prior to submitting to the Structured Learning Experience Coordinator.
- 7. Each year community service must be pre-approved and verified by the Structured Learning Experience Coordinator.
- 8. Students must have their Community Service Record Form completed in its entirety with signatures and contact information of the community service organization's supervisor.
- 9. Students must submit their Community Service Record Form by the posted deadline date.
- 10. Hours will be recorded on student transcripts. Transcripts will indicate if the student has met their requirement or has not met the requirement.

*All requirements stated for students of OHS are also required of students of CIAO, STEM, and 9th grade students of OPA.
