By acknowledging our diverse backgrounds, we foster creative students who are self-motivated, curious, leaders, and foster the love of learning.




We are committed to social justice and developing children's advocacy and activism skills to be leaders of a more just and equitable world by honoring and respecting our diverse backgrounds.






Late to School or Sick Children

Attendance

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Handbook


Our handbook is available online with detailed information about Gifted Education.
