

Fundamentals of Health and Wellness

provides a comprehensive overview of health and wellness. The course will explore the impact of lifestyle choice on all aspects of personal health. Topics will include nutrition, fitness, stress management, disease prevention, substance abuse and healthy relationships with an emphasis on self-responsibility.

Dynamics of Health Care in Society

is an orientation to health care and delivery, from an interdisciplinary perspective with a focus on critical thinking, ethical reasoning, effective communication and self-directed learning abilities. General issues and topics common to all health care providers will be stressed. Emphasis is placed on the role of the health care practitioner as both provider and consumer of health care services.

Medical Terminology 1 and 2

is the study of words that pertain to body systems, anatomy, physiology, medical processes and procedures and diseases.

Emergency and Clinical Care

Is designed to give the student the knowledge and confidence to recognize and respond to a medical emergency. Students are prepared to obtain a patient medical history, take and record vital signs and acquire CPR certification.

Health Occupations

Provides career and college readiness with hands on training. Areas covered include skills, responsibilities and workplace safety for medical settings. Structured learning at medical facilities in the area is embedded into this course. Note: This course is for seniors who have participated in all of the other courses in this track.
