SHAMROCK MEMORY MATCH

This game is great to play anytime during the month of March. It can be set up in a center for your students to play when they get done with their work early.

It is a wonderful game to help children work on their memory skills, and it also helps younger children practice their visual discrimination skills.

Print out the shamrock cards on white cardstock and cut the pages evenly into fourths. I like to laminate them for added durability so they can be used year after year.

Use the appropriate number of cards for your age group and have the children try to make matches by turning over two cards at a time. If a child does not make a match, it is the next child's turn. If a child turns over two matching cards, he/she gets to keep the match and then it is the next child's turn. If a child turns over both of the "lucky gold coins," he/she gets an additional turn! The child with the most matches at the end wins the game!
