AS YOU ARE AWARE, HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH BEGAN ON SEPTEMBER 15, 2023 AND WILL CONCLUDE ON OCTOBER 15, 2023. ALL SCHOOLS WILL HAVE A HOSTING OF ACTIVITIES TO CELEBRATE THE HISPANIC CULTURE. PLEASE BE ON THE LOOK OUT FOR THESE EVENTS SO YOU CAN BE A PART OF THEM. A LITTLE HISTORY ABOUT HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH: HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH ACTUALLY BEGAN AS A COMMEMORATIVE WEEK WHEN IT WAS FIRST INTRODUCED IN JUNE OF 1968 BY CALIFORNIA CONGRESSMAN GEORGE E. BROWN.

THE PUSH TO RECOGNIZE THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE LATINX COMMUNITY HAD GAINED MOMENTUM THROUGHOUT THE 1960'S WHEN THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT WAS AT ITS PEAK AND THERE WAS A GROWING AWARENESS OF THE UNITED STATES' MULTICULTURAL IDENTITIES.

ON SEPTEMBER 14, 1989, PRESIDENT GEORGE H.W. BUSH WHO HAD BEEN A SPONSOR OF THE ORIGINAL HISPANIC HERITAGE WEEK RESOLUTION WHILE SERVING IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN 1968 BECAME THE FIRST PRESIDENT TO DECLARE THE 31-DAY PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 15TH TO OCTOBER 15TH AS NATIONAL HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH.

#### NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH AND BREAKFAST PROGRAM REMINDER:

The Orange Public School District is participating in a federal program available to select schools as part of the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). Our participation means that all students attending the Orange Public Schools are eligible to receive breakfast and lunch at no charge throughout the current school year.

Annually, our families must complete the Household Information Survey in order for us to provide the Department of Education with the information it needs to ensure that our district will continue to receive critical state funding. Each family must return the completed survey, distributed at each school, to their principal or designee by Wednesday, September 20, 2023.
