WHEREAS, up to 5 students will engage in NJIT's course FRSC 201 Introduction to Forensic Science on NJIT's campus with the option for the District to offer the course through NJIT's Options Program for a reduced rate (approximately \$150 per credit); and

WHEREAS, the course upon approval will be entered into the Orange Public Schools' 2022-2023 Program of Study as **NJIT's Forensic Science** (High School: 5 credits; NJIT: 3 credits) *Prerequisite: Biology, Chemistry, Teacher recommendation; Corequisite: Physics*

Course Description: Forensic Science is the application of science to the law. This course introduces students to the m any disciplines of forensic science and how they are used in our criminal justice system. Students will be introduced to the science behind these disciplines and how forensic science techniques are used in crime laboratories throughout the United States and abroad. Guest lecturers and practitioners will offer insights into their day-to-day investigative work and how they face technological challenges and success. The scientific method will be emphasized throughout the course; and
