We are in **PHASE 1**: All instruction will take place virtually. Students are to log on every day to google meets promptly at 8:30. Synchronous instruction will take place from 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM Monday through Friday.

**WHAT IS SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING?** Synchronous “distance” learning – where the learning group interacts at the same time, from different physical locations – is one of the major forms of **distance education**, and it offers a number of key advantages for educators and students alike.

↳ *This means we will all be online, live, together for the allotted time. Students are to be in a proper learning environment, cameras on, actively participating in the lesson at hand. Students are required to attend all classes and small group instruction.*

## Where to find assignments?

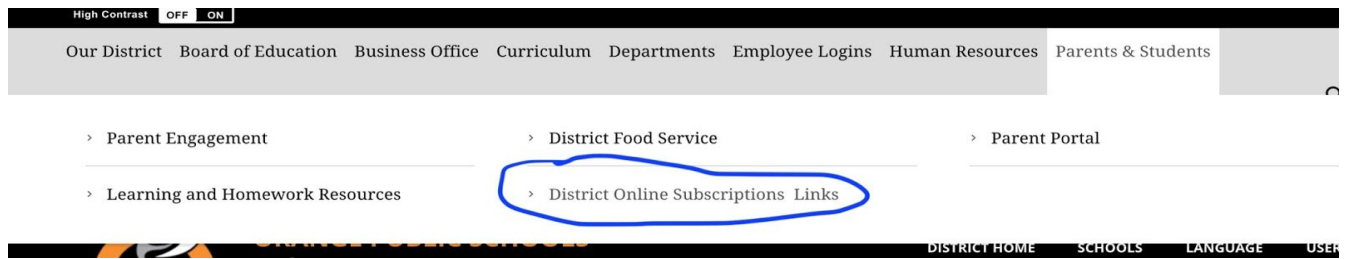

### Requirements:
