This resource is intended to relieve your stress at the beginning of the year so that you can focus on getting your classroom ready, on getting your main curriculum planning done, and on attending the many meetings we are all required to attend at the start of a school year. If you are anything like me, I tend to focus on the big picture planning, and then the first week nitty-gritty planning can get left to the last minute! By having this resource, you will be able to plan your first week easily!

There are math and literacy components in this resource that should last you a minimum of one week. There are 14 literacy and 14 math activities/printables along with lesson plan ideas. Use the ones that meet your needs, and remember that second graders are really still first graders in the first week of school! After a long summer they will require some time to warm up to pencil and paper activities, so just choose the printables that work for you! In my experience, the activities have lasted more than one week.

I have simplified my copyright information on these pages, so as to not confuse students about the grade level of their pages.

Directions for...

“All About Me”

Read a Story about Back to school, such as “I am Too Absolutely Small for School,” by Lauren Child, or “First Grade Jitters,” by Julie Danneberg, or “Froggy Goes to School,” by Jonathan London.

As a class, discuss what the students will be filling in on the page. Review the spelling of the school name. If your students need extra support and your school name is very long, you may wish to fill in that spot by hand before photocopying the sheet.

Encourage students to draw a picture of themselves as they really look today (hair color, clothing color, etc.) If possible, provide small mirrors for the students to look at themselves!

“My Favorite Things”


Have a chart prepared that has several topics for “favorite things”, such as animals, food, colors, sports. Give students the opportunity to “pair share” their favorites of each of those. To do a pair share they turn to a partner and take turns sharing their answer. After a few moments, redirect the attention back to you, and have several partners share what the other person said. This can ensure that the partners actually listen to each other. Write down those examples on the chart.

Directions for... "About My Name"

Review Vowels and Consonants: Ensure that students remember the difference between vowels and consonants.

Demonstrate the activity very clearly. You can do the activity one step at a time as a whole class to avoid many students requiring help at the same time.

If your students are having difficulties remembering the difference between vowels and consonants, you can have all of the students shade the vowels with yellow first.

Read-Aloud: You might choose to read a book before beginning the name sorting activity. Suggestions: "My Name is Yoon" by Helen Recorvits, "Chrysanthemum" by Kevin Henkes, "The Name Jar" by Yangsook Choi,

Early Learners:

Have students first circle the letters in their name before they cut. Then they glue those circled letters in the left column.

When their name letters are complete, they glue the remaining letters in the right column.

Advanced Option:

Option A: Paste the letters in each column in alphabetical order

Option B: Paste the letters divided by consonants and vowels in each column. Have them glue the vowels on top and the consonants below, as in this example:




Directions for...

“All About My Teacher”

Whole Group: Gather students at your meeting place. Have chart paper set up with teacher’s name at the top and divide it into four rectangles like the student page.

Go over the four “about the teacher” sections.

1. Ask students to describe some of your characteristics such as hair length and color, glasses, and clothing. Show a simple way to draw the head and shoulders.



2. Ask students to think about their favorite animal. Turn and ask two neighbors what their favorite animal is. Share with the class what yours is (or make it a guessing game!), and draw it simply on the chart.
3. Tell the students a bit about your love for books and reading. Have your favorite book available. Show the cover of the book and tell a little bit about the book. Draw a simple picture that represents the book. Write the title in the circle as well. You might want to plan to read that book to them, or use a book you have already read to the students.
4. Talk about the wide variety of subjects your students will be studying this year. Tell what your favorite subject is. Draw a simple picture to represent your favorite subject.

Seatwork:

Students complete the “All About My Teacher page, using the chart as a guide.

Brainstorm a list of genres or topics of books that your students enjoy reading. Put the list on your whiteboard or on a chart paper. After completing the brainstorm, have the students “pair-share” their favorite one or two topics. Students then complete the page by finishing the sentence starter *they may use the brainstorm you completed as a class or the word bank on the page. They then draw a picture and complete the emotion response.

“MY FIRST WEEK”

At some point each day (right after lunch, for example) have the students draw or write about one thing that they did at school that day.

There are five versions (lined, unlined, with 4 days, with 5 days (Many schools start with a four-day week). There is also a writing page to do at the end of the week as a reflection on the week as a whole. Choose which works for you!

“MY SCHOOL GOALS”

You may wish to read a story about goal-setting, such as “This School Year will be the BEST!” by Kay Winters.

Discuss activities and skills that your students are really good at. Complete sentences on chart paper or on a white board with “expert statements.” For example, “Jocelyn is an expert at drawing.” “Ben is an expert at dancing.”


Next, make a class brainstorm chart about things that the students would


“I know Digraphs”

Review the digraphs and their sounds. Students cut and paste the digraphs ch, sh, wh, and th onto the appropriate spot and print the digraph to match.



“I know vowels”

Review short and long vowel sounds. Remind the students that the long vowels “say their name” For this activity students sort short a and long a sounds. Two versions of the page are provided. One has the words printed and one has only the pictures. Choose what works for you.



“I print sight words”

Review some first grade sight words. Use a PowerPoint to review, or flash cards, or words that might already be on your word wall. Alternately, play a YouTube video of sight words. (Simply go to YouTube and search “First Grade Sight Words”).

Students then complete the printable by reading the sentences (do it together if your students need support) and then print the appropriate missing word in each sentence.



Directions for...

“I Print Letters”

Have students print each letter on the line several times, using finger spaces. Next they color the pictures and trace the letters at the bottom of the page. Keep for your records as a sample of beginning of the year letter printing, or send home in packet. Do one page per day. You might not need to do these pages with your second graders. Assess to see if these pages are appropriate for the level of your group of students.

Talk about summer activities across a wide range. “Getting to know my class”

Give each child a copy of one of the “Getting to know my class” pages. (There are two different versions, so you can play it twice!). I like to give the students a clipboard for this activity, but it isn’t necessary. Students go around the class asking a child one of the questions. If the answer is “yes”, the child writes his/her initials in the box. Keep going until most students have finished. Fast finishers can meet at the carpet and compare their answers, or draw on the back of their page.


“Color by Addition & Subtraction”



Review Addition and Subtraction to 10 with these color by number pages. Students might benefit from first coloring the key at the bottom and then solving the equations.






1) Find your Group: Using as many cards as needed (one card each, use multiples of 4 to ensure complete groupings) hand out one card to each student. Students must find their group where all four cards represent the same number. For example, in a class of 24, I would use 6 sets of 4 cards, mix them up, and then distribute. When a group is complete, they sit down and wait for the other groups to find each other. If you have 27 students, you would have 7 complete sets of cards (28 cards), but you would give one student 2 cards from the same set, or the teacher uses one card.



2) Least to Greatest: Separate the cards into 4 stacks of one type of card. For example, one stack of lion (numerals), zebra (blocks), elephants (ten-frames), and hippos (tallies). Each set needs to be put in order of least to greatest.

3) Odd/Even sort: Simply mix up the cards and sort into two piles.

4) War: Mix up the cards (all four types). Play in partners. Each player gets 5 cards. Without looking at the cards, each player turns over one card. The highest number wins the hand and gets to keep both cards. If the number is the same, turn (If the green cards are too difficult for your particular group, you can use the blue 1-10 cards.)
