Interview Directions

This product contains differentiated interview forms for your students to use when they interview a classmate. You might choose to provide each student with the same form, or you can differentiate based on your understanding of your students' needs. The forms have slightly different questions, so you can choose which you prefer.


Before giving the forms to your students, you might wish to demonstrate the interview by interviewing one of the students yourself.


After the students have interviewed each other, it is ideal to gather the students together once again and share out information that was gathered. You could either ask for volunteers or go around in a circle sharing information about each partner.

For the page with illustrations of dice, the intention is that each student rolls a die to determine which section from the Interview will be shared with the whole class. This adds fun and chance to the sharing session. Depending on the length of time you have available, you could have students roll the die only once, or more times! Alternately, you could put the students into small groups and have the students take turns rolling a die and then go around the small group each answering that particular question.






















Interview

What did you do during the summer break?


What do you like to do for fun?
