CORONAVIRUS MOBILE TESTING VAN IS COMING TO ORANGE

The City Of Orange Township and Salerno Medical Associates Will Provide COVID - 19 Testing for Orange Residents Beginning Monday, May 4. REGISTRATION REQUIRED

A Mobile Testing Unit will be available for Orange residents to undergo tests for COVID19.

Testing for Orange Residents begins on May 4 through May 8, from 10:45 am to 6:00 pm at the following locations:

- Monday, May 4 at the **Orange Police Station**, 29 Park Street, Orange, NJ
- Tuesday, May 5 at **City Hall**, 29 North Day Street, Orange, NJ
- Wednesday, May 6 at the **Orange Fire Department**, 419 Central Avenue, Orange, NJ

More testing dates and locations will be announced.

All insurance is accepted. I.D. is required. If you have “managed care”, then you need a referral from your doctor to get tested. Medicare and Medicaid are accepted. If you do not have insurance, Medicare or Medicaid, please bring your Social Security card to be tested. If you do not have insurance, Medicare, Medicaid or a Social Security card, please bring a **check, money order or cash in the amount of \$152.15.**

Testing is for Orange residents only.

The test will take about 10 minutes and will be administered with a nasal swab by a licensed nurse or physician.

Due to the anticipated crowd, please obey signs and directions when you arrive and **OBSERVE ALL SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES**
