

Created and led by DaShawn Usher, the director of GLAAD's Communities of Color and Media department, along with associate director Julian J. Walker and junior associate Kayla Thompson, the initiative — which is also supported by Gilead Sciences — is designed as a pipeline program to help address, and begin to resolve, the existing gap in equitable representation onscreen and behind the scenes in Hollywood.







Intro to Digital Media

This course is designed to educate students on the ever changing digital world of visual effects. Students will learn about the fundamentals of storytelling, camera movements, storyboarding, visual effects using blue/green screen backdrop in our T.V. Studio. Students will be shooting T.V. commericals, Advertisements, Public Service Announcements. Interviews, and more.

Digital Media students, will gain hands on experience learning about various fields 2D/3D Animation, Stop Motion Animation and Voice Over.

Students in this program will also produce their own Stop Motion animated short film, followed by a 3D Animated Short Film, using Character Animator.

Digital Media students will also create online portfolios, which coincide with Career Readiness within the CTE program at Orange High School.






Filmmaking

They will also master various roles of production as a Producer, Director, Gaffer, A.D., Production Assistant, Editor, Director of Photography and Boom Operator.









Digital Media - In-depth Overview of The Program

• Digital Media :Focus and objectives:

Students will analyze and research job roles and responsibilities in the film industry.

Students will demonstrate and research camera movements used for cinematography and storytelling. They will also be able to master editing techniques, color correction, and VFX in Adobe Premiere.



Students will analyze 3 Arc Structure used for plot development and storytelling.

Students will research and analyze proper scriptwriting terms, using the Celtx program. They will develop 2-3 page screenplay, create a shot list, script outline, call sheet, and shooting schedule as a team.

Digital Media Overview:

• Students studied proper editing techniques used for color correction, formatting for video, VFX using Green Screen, and graphics.

- News Report, T.V. Commercial, PSA Horror Film Trailer using visual effects, text elements.
- Students are paired up in teams of 4-5 students. Each student has the opportunity to be a Producer, Director, A.D, D.P, Actor and Editor.

Filmmaking Overview:

Students wrote, 2-3 page screenplay for "The First Day of School," using Celtx, which is a scriptwriting software used in the Film Industry.

Projects: First Day of School, Horror Short. 2 - 3 page script, which includes the following used in film production: shot list, call sheet, shooting schedule.

Each week students film the short film during class and edit using Adobe Premiere.

Next week will be starting a new Unit - Podcasting.
