Dear Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers,

I trust you are enjoying your summer and are looking forward to our return to school. We are excited for the start of the 2024-2025 school year at Rosa Parks Community School!

I must begin by introducing you to our two new Assistant Principals, Mr. Gerald Murphy (joining us from Heywood Avenue School) and Mrs. Naga Philkhana (new to our District). They bring a wealth of knowledge and experience to our team.

**Return to School Dates and times for Students:** Please be reminded that students report for the first day of school on Friday, September 6, 2024. Students must arrive no later than 8:30 am; dismissal is at 3:00pm.

Please see the information below regarding school procedures:

### **MORNING ROUTINE FOR STUDENTS**

- Students must arrive to school by 8:20 a.m. We will accept students beginning at 7:50 am. Attendance is vital to instructional supports for our students. We need our students on time and present each day.
- Students are dropped off and proceed as follows.
  - Grade 3-7 students will enter the building through the gymnasium, Door #2.
     (Grade 3 students and parents enter together on September 6<sup>th</sup>.) Parents are asked to stand around the perimeter of the gym to support their students)
- Students will have breakfast in the classroom this school year.
- Teachers will meet their students as follows: Grade 3, 4 and 5 in the gymnasium at 8:30 a.m. and grades 6 and 7 in the cafeteria also at 8:30 a.m.

#### **DISMISSAL**

- All students are dismissed at 3:00 p.m.
- Please arrive promptly at that time to pick up your child.
- In the event that you are unable to pick up your child on a certain day, please provide prompt, written notification to the main office. Please include the name of the person who will serve in your capacity.
- Students are dismissed from the following locations as follows.
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students in rooms 102, 103 and 104 are dismissed from the main door, Door#1.
  - o 4<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed from the Main Entrance, Door # 1.
  - o 5<sup>th</sup> Grade students will be dismissed from the gymnasium Door # 2
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed from exit Door # 4 (alley between CES and RPCS) onto Cleveland Street.

# **STUDENT ATTIRE**

Students should dress appropriately for a school setting. Sneakers must always be worn for physical education classes. Uniforms should be worn daily. RPCS also has a gym uniform.

#### **Uniforms**

To help create an environment conducive to learning, there is a formal dress code for Rosa Parks Community School. Please note that the uniform policy will be strictly enforced.

# Elementary School students in grades 3 and 4 are to wear:

- navy pants (boys or girls)
- navy jumper (girls)
- white or light blue polo shirt with a collar (boys and girls)

# Middle School students in grades 5-7 are to wear:

- khaki pants (boys or girls)
- white polo shirt with a collar (boys and girls)

# **Physical Education Dress Code**

On students scheduled physical education day, students must wear their gym uniforms to school. The formal physical education dress code in grades 3-7 is to wear:

- solid gray or solid navy sweat suits
- solid gray or solid navy shorts (must be knee length) and t-shirt or Purple Rosa Parks t-shirt.
- gym uniforms are available for purchase at Rosa Parks Community School.

Appropriate and safe footwear must be worn at all times. Specifically, flip-flops or "sliders" are not to be worn due to the safety factor when using stairs.
