MORNING ROUTINE FOR STUDENTS:

- Doors will open at 7:45 am to receive all K-7 students. Students must wear the appropriate school uniform to school.
- The following entrances will be used to enter the building:
 - All students will enter through the main entrance and report to their designated locations.
 - Students will be required to sign-in all cell phones with their homeroom teacher (8:30am).
- Students should bring their Chromebooks fully charged to school each day. (No personal devices)
- All classroom instruction will begin promptly at 8:30 am.

DISMISSAL:

- Pre-K and Kindergarten students will be dismissed from the student cafeteria (Must be signed-out by authorized individuals listed on emergency form ONLY).
- 1st through 3rd grade student will be dismissed from the student's school yard to parents or designee (Inclement weather students will be dismissed from the Multi-Purpose Room).
- 4th through 7th Grade will be dismissed from the greenhouse exit.
- Bused students will be dismissed as per bus schedule.

MASK MANDATE UPDATE: Effective Tuesday, July 5, 2022, the mask mandate moved to an optional status for our district school and administrative buildings. If there is an uptick in cases within the school district, Dr. Fitzhugh, Superintendent of Schools, will reserve the option to return to mandatory masks for an unspecified period. Please continue to remain safe as we are embarking on a school year that will filled with greatness for students and staff. As a district, we will continue with COVID testing. This of course is optional, but we felt the success we had with the program and deem it necessary at this moment to continue the initiative.

STUDENT ATTIRE:

Students should dress appropriately for a school setting. Sneakers must always be worn for physical education classes. Uniforms should be worn daily. It is the expectation of the following in terms of dress:

Boys (PreK-7th Grade)

- Collared Shirts: Long or Short Sleeved (White with bow tie)
- Pants: Khaki
- Sweaters: Pull-over or button down (Forest Green with emblem)

Girls (PreK-7th Grade)

- Collared Shirts: Long or Short Sleeved (White with bow tie)
- Pants/Skirts: Khaki
- Sweaters: Pull-over or button-down (Forest Green with emblem)
- Girls may wear solid color white or green tights

The following items of clothing are considered to be inappropriate and are not to be worn:

• Blouses or sweaters that show a bare midriff, halter tops, bandanas, tank tops, tops with thin

straps, short shorts, short mini-skirts, clinging or form fitting spandex leggings (*without the appropriate length skorts, shorts, skirt, or dress*), pants/jeans worn below the waist, and pants/jeans with rips 4" above the knee (including any rip that shows through to skin, undergarments, or fabric.). All flannel-type pants and sleepwear are not permitted.

• Appropriate and safe footwear must be worn at all times. Specifically, no flip-flops or "sliders" are not to be worn due to the safety factor when using stairs. All sandals must be secured at the toes and ankle for safety.

SCHEDULES KIOSK: We are passing out schedules on Thursday, August 25, 2022, from 9:00 AM until 12:00 PM (K-3rd grade) 1:00PM until 3:30PM (4th-7thgrade) and Friday, August 26, 2022 from 9:00 AM until 12:00 PM (4th-7th grade) 1:00PM until 3:30PM (K-3rd grade).

STUDENT ABSENCES

Parents are responsible for reporting daily absences to the FSCS Main Office at 973-677-4120. The district policy indicates that a student must be in attendance for 163 or more school days in order to be considered to have successfully completed the instructional program requirements of the grade/course to which he/she is assigned.

FORMS:

Students will receive the emergency contact form on the first day of school. Please review and complete the emergency form and other corresponding forms by September 12, 2022. It is important that these forms are returned so we are able to have active communication with you throughout SY 22-23.

<u>AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS</u>: FSCS Afterschool Programs will begin early October 2022. Further communication to come in September regarding after school programming. The following programs will be offered on various days and times:

- The YMCA will offer after school programs for grade K-7th
- Project Achieve Academic Program for Grades K-7 will be offered Tuesday-Thursday from 3pm-4pm for identified students.
- Various clubs will be for grades 3-7 from Tuesday-Thursday 3pm-4pm

CHROMEBOOKS

Students are to bring their district issued Chromebook to school on a daily basis; full charged.
