## 11. Principal's Update: Budget for Next Year (Goals #1, #2, and #3)

• FSS has been working on a flat budget.

- Trips needed to have been scheduled before winter break. All budgeted trip money was exhausted.
- Disney budget will be factored in for next year.
- Ms. Cooke will continue working on budget.
- Budget is due on 1/30/17
- Face-to-face Budget Meeting 2/3/17
- Disney production sent an email inviting 49 students to go watch Disney's Lion King Production in Manhattan.
- Transportation Fees: for Ask parents for \$10.00 per student, if parents express a financial hardship, monies will be withdrawn from Disney budget.
- Chromebooks are not as sturdy as previous Dells. Currently researching the lifespan/sturdiness of new technology.
- Micro-Society/After-School Program
- This is currently FSS 4th year of extended school day (4 pm dismissal).
- Teacher attendance directly impacts this program. We are currently under 6 teachers.
- Due to the lack of teacher coverage, FSS may have to return to a 3pm dismissal with a focus on remediation.
- HOWEVER, data has shown that since we've been conducting a 4pm dismissal, students have been moving up academically.
- Remediation, cannot be an afterschool program.
- If we lose Micro (entire school 4pm dismissal), we will not get it back.
- This issue will be addressed in the next staff meeting.
