Meeting to Order:

- 2. SMT Retreat August Minutes will be retrieved and reviewed post-current meeting.

Address Student Transitions:

- Ms. Cooke will generate memo to all teachers regarding students.
- All teachers, general and special, are responsible for students. They must be held accountable. If they are out, they are to return.
- Suggestion to take attendance and always know count.

Old Business:

- 1. Data Meeting
 - a. Meeting was held four times to discuss: focus areas, tools and put together a PowerPoint presentation
 - b. Ms. Romain collected K-2 ELA and some math data.
 - i. She was commended for being specific as to who the students are (Tiers 2 and 3) and how they are performing.
 - c. Ms. Hunter collected K-7 Math Data.
 - d. Ms. Stokes collected 3-7 ELA data.
 - e. Ms. Cooke, Mrs. Delgado, Mrs. Murphy, and Ms. Willis monitor new special education and I&RS requests.
 - i. Student attendance will be reviewed after second marking period.
 - f. Data will provide Ms. Hanson for Intervention support.
 - i. Ms. Cooke suggested students be pulled out for support.
 - ii. Mrs. Antunes agreed with suggestion because it will provide less distraction for student and it's preferred for one-to-one support.
 - g. Data team will present PowerPoint at next staff meeting.
 - i. K-2 will break up to discuss data and intervention with Ms. Romain and Ms. Hanson.
 - ii. Ms. Stokes will focus on Reading Plus with 3-7 ELA teachers. Strategies will be discussed to address students without technology.
 - iii. Ms. Hunter will use NWEA math report to discuss with 3-7 math teachers.

h. Reading Plus and iRead

i. Should be made a big deal for students to celebrate progress and achievements.

- ii. Connect reading programs to the real world.
- iii. Ms. Murphy suggested the use of the Naviance career inventory in grades 6-7.

i. "The Future Me" project

- i. K-2 students will work with parents to identify what is needed and goals towards achieving future aspiration.
- ii. Project to be completed in March prior to PARCC.
- iii. A form of an essay to be created per grade.
- iv. If students are interested in an athletic or "superstar" career, they must include detailed requirements and training needed to achieve goal.

- a. Ms. Mueses stated that some students were not aware that they could stay.
- b. Parents must accompany students. Moving forward, this requirement will continue to be made clear via phone blasts and noted on the flyer.
- c. Ms. Cooke suggested a structured activity be planned to occupy students.
- d. Recognize Mr. Gamboa for planning and assistance.

3. Cinderella, Cast-Parents Interest Meeting 10/24/17

- a. Majority of parents in attendance.
 - i. Parents agreed to assist.
 - ii. Decal can be designed to create t-shirts for parents and students.

- a. About seventy parents in attendance.

- c. A few parents rated event as meeting (2) their expectations.

- e. Suggestion to hold Spring Shadow Day, in the afternoon, on picture day.
- f. Post parent "testimonials" on Forest Street School website after holding events.
 - i. Develop general standard parent survey.

- c. Plan next year's event prior to the end of the year.

 - a. Elect teacher/paraprofessional for Governor's Teacher of the Year based on requirements
 - i. Decision must be made prior to Thanksgiving to allow ample time for teacher to write essays
 - ii. Present at upcoming staff meeting
 - b. FSS government (Pantherville) process by Election Day, 11/7/17
 - i. Students will vote for mayor, deputy mayor treasurer and secretary
