Meeting to Order

Old Business

- 1. <u>Reading Plus Lessons and Interventions</u>
 - a. A decline in student scores has been observed.
 - i. Students who have met the goal are now being rewarded.
 - ii. Previously, students who were not meeting their goals were taken from their lunch periods. This method was not showing student progress.
 - b. A math data component is needed to be developed by math teachers.
 - i. Dreambox Math (student websites) began the week of December 4th. Ms. Irving can license to teachers of ESL and resource students. It is an adaptive, remedial program that re-teaches skills, offers challenges and included repetition. Dreambox is aligned to grade level standards.
 - c. Lack of available technology at home
 - i. Many students are not able to access online programs at home.
 - ii. Ms. Irving suggested that the technology lab have "open lab" student time
 - slots before and after school.
- 2. <u>Teacher of the Year</u>
 - a. A total of 4 nominations were completed.
 - i. 3 teacher of the year and 1 paraprofessional of the year.
 - ii. Staff and parents were asked to join the selection committee to vote.
 - iii. The selection committee of 8 staff members and 1 parent member (Mr. Gamboa) voted for each category.
 - iv. The winners were shared.
 - v. Next step: Ms. Cooke will announce winners to accept their nominations

 - a. The question of how the washing machine will be used was presented.
 - i. Students may be able to use for personal laundry or as a venture where local businesses can use.
 - ii. Mr. Lorenzo volunteered to question all staff members to receive their input and suggestions
