Orange High School students will participate in the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) this Spring. The NJSLA is used to assess students' progress in English, Mathematics and Science. The assessment will be administered to students fitting the following criteria:

✓ **NJSLA-ELA9:** Any student enrolled in ELA I

✓ **NJSLA-Math:** All students in Algebra I

Grade 9 student enrolled in Algebra II or Geometry

✓ **NJSLA-Science:** Grade 11 students currently enrolled in any Science course.

The assessment schedule is below. Students that are not scheduled for testing will report to the building at 10:15 a.m. on the testing dates.

This assessment can be used to fulfill students' assessment requirements for graduation in English and Mathematics. The assessment is administered in computer-based (CBT) format, please encourage your child to fully charge and bring their school issued device with them on the testing day. Practice Tests are also available in the portal for ELA, mathematics, and science. The practice tests are designed to allow users to view and interact with the sample items in the same way students interacted with them during testing. The practice test platforms have a default login of "Guest"; however, users can choose to enter a name when they begin. Users can respond to sample test items and receive a summary score for each unit. Additional resources such as the Digital Item Library and New Meridian Item Library are also available. Please have your child bring their charged device with them on the day of testing.
