Dear Parent/Guardian,

This letter is to inform you that this year all summer school courses will be virtual! We strongly encourage that you and your child to take full advantage of this opportunity to enroll in our credit recovery courses to stay on track for graduation or enrichment courses to prepare students for college. Students that have failed courses and who do not take advantage of the summer credit recovery option will need to make up the required course work during the 2020–2021 school year along with their full year schedule in order to stay on track for graduation. This may include taking credit recovery classes in our Twilight Program.

What are the Dates and Time for Summer Courses?

Notes: No classes on July 3rd

AP Courses	July 1 st – July 31 st	8:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon
Pre-Calculus	July 1 st – July 31 st	8:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon
SAT Math Prep	July 1 st – July 31 st	8:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon

What is the attendance Policy?

Students will be automatically dropped from the summer school program if they have 4 or more absences.

How will the Summer Courses be Taught?

- For our teachers to provide your child with quality instruction and support, students are required to attend virtual classes every day.
- Students will receive live instruction from their teacher as well as work independently online to complete coursework.
- Teachers will be accessible every day during their office hours
- Summer school administrator will be available every day from 8:00a.m. – 4:00p.m.

How will Attendance be Measured?

- Students must log in for the session they are enrolled for live instruction and complete coursework.

How Do Students enroll in Summer Courses?

- Any student that is currently failing a course at OHS can enroll for summer courses.
- Students can take a maximum of two credit recovery courses.

- Students should work with their assigned guidance counselors to identify and enroll in courses that are needed for credit recovery.
