After School Remediation Programs at Orange High School

Orange High School currently facilitates four programs after school to support students who are not experiencing success in the day school and as a result need remediation after school. The following alternative programs are designed as small units, with carefully selected staff who provide intense, comprehensive services to students and their families:

- 1. Orange Alternative High School (3:30-8:00 pm M-F)-**
Orange Alternative High School offers a non-traditional, yet effective learning environment that provides a flexible educational objective that is closely related to the learning styles and the individual needs of students, while addressing the Core Curriculum Content Standards.
- 2. Credit Recovery Program (3:30-8:00pm M-F)-**
The Credit recovery program involves students taking or retaking classes that students failed or did not take during the regular school year. Students are allowed and encouraged to take the courses after school so that they can obtain credits to meet their graduation requirements. Our credit recovery program allows students to take classes in person and make up work vial Google classroom. Once students pass credit recovery courses, they are back on track towards graduation and ready to take other classes in the Orange High School curriculum.
- 3. In School Suspension (ISS) from 3:30-5:30 pm M-F**
The In-school Suspension program is designed to provide immediate intervention for students that are experiencing disciplinary issues that do not require outside suspension. These issues need to be addressed in order to maintain the climate and culture of the school and reduce the impact on instruction. Our In- School Suspension program allows time for students to reflect on their issues and build a relationship with a caring adult who thinks they are worthwhile.
- 4. After School Tutoring (3:30-4:30 pm)-**
Orange High school offers tutoring for all students in three different modalities in most subject areas. We have computer- based programs to help students improve their proficiency in Math (KHAN Academy) and Reading (Reading Plus). We have traditional tutoring provided by teachers and we have peer to peer tutoring in all subjects, which is facilitated by our Advanced Proficiency (AP) students under Ms. Shaw.
