MORNING ROUTINE FOR STUDENTS:

Weather permitting, students will proceed to their homeroom lines on the blacktop. Should the weather be inclement, students will proceed to identified locations within the building after entering the main entrance.

- Students are not permitted to arrive at school until (7:45am). Students must wear the appropriate school uniform at all times. (Please do not have your child arrive prior to 7:45am as there will not be Supervision)
- The following locations (entrances) will be used to enter the building:
 - Pre-K (Walk the path of the building and drop off will be at the TCU Door)
 - o Gr. K Gr. 7 (Main Entrance)
- Students should bring their Chromebooks fully charged to school each day. (Personal devices are not allowed)
- All classes will begin promptly at 8:30am (Students will be marked TARDY after this time)

DISMISSAL:

- Students will exit the building via the locations below:
 - Pre-K (Front of Main Entrance Doors/Main Entrance)
 - o Gr. K 2 (Annex Doors)
 - Gr. 3 7 (Side Doors next to Main Entrance)

PARKING:

- Please adhere to all parking regulations as determined by the Orange Police Department
 - Between 7:30am-8:30am (Heywood Avenue will only travel towards Lincoln Avenue) - ONE WAY
 - O Between 2:30pm-3:30pm (Heywood Avenue will only travel towards Lincoln Avenue) - ONE WAY
 - There should be no Double Parking at anytime
 - At no time should parents drive/park in the school parking lots as they are active passage ways for students.

MASK MANDATE UPDATE: Effective Tuesday, July 5th, 2022, the mask mandate moved to an optional status for our district school and administrative buildings. If there is an uptick in cases within the school district, Dr. Fitzhugh, Superintendent of Schools, will reserve the option to return to mandatory masks for an unspecified period. Please continue to remain safe as we are embarking on a school year that will be filled with greatness for students and staff. As a district, we will continue with COVID testing. This of course is optional, but we felt the success we had with the program and deem it necessary at this moment to continue the initiative.

STUDENT ATTIRE:

Students should dress appropriately for a school setting. Sneakers must be worn for physical education classes. **Uniforms must be worn daily**. It is the expectation of the following in terms of dress:

Boys (Pre-K - Gr. 7)

- Collared Shirts: White or Light Blue Polo or Oxford shirt
- Pants: Navy Blue Pants (Pre-K Gr. 7) or Khaki Pants (Gr. 5 Gr. 7 only)
- Sweater (Seasonal): Navy Blue Sweater
- *Tie*: (Optional)

Girls (Pre-K - Gr. 7)

- Collared Shirts: White or Light Blue Polo or Oxford shirt
- Pants/Skirt/Skort/Dress Jumper:
 - Navy Blue Pants/Skirt/Skort/Dress Jumper (Pre-K Gr. 7) or Khaki (Gr. 5 Gr. 7 only) Pants/Skirt/Skort/Dress Jumper
- *Tights/Socks*: White or Blue Tights/Socks
- Sweater (Seasonal): Navy Blue Sweater

Boys/Girls (PE Requirement)

• White, light blue, navy or gray t-shirts and/or sweatshirts with navy blue or gray shorts/sweatpants.

The following items of clothing are considered to be inappropriate and are not to be worn:

- Blouses or sweaters that show a bare midriff, halter tops, bandanas, tank tops, tops with thin straps, short shorts, short mini-skirts, clinging or form fitting spandex leggings (without the appropriate length skorts, shorts, skirt, or dress), pants/jeans worn below the waist, and pants/jeans with rips 4" above the knee (including any rip that shows through to skin, undergarments, or fabric.). All flannel-type pants and sleepwear are not permitted (unless directed for Spirit Day celebration and appropriate guidelines will be provided)
- Pants that hang below the waist without proper support
- Non-Religious headgear (i.e. Durags, bonnets, scarfs, etc)
- Flip-Flops and/or "sliders" (Appropriate and safe footwear must be worn at all times due to the safety factor when using stairs)

STUDENT ABSENCES:

Parents are responsible for reporting daily absences to the Heywood Main Office at 973-677-4105. The district policy indicates that a student must be in attendance for 163 or more school days in order to be considered to have successfully completed the instructional program requirements of the grade/course to which he/she is assigned.

FORMS:

Students will receive the emergency contact form on the first day of school. Please review and complete the emergency form and other corresponding forms by (Monday), September 12, 2022. It is important that these forms are returned so we are able to have active communication with you throughout SY 22-23.

- E-mail & phone blasts will also be used to communicate with families. (We highly encourage all guardians to ensure that you have updated your contact information in Genesis. It is imperative that all school personnel have the most updated information for your household)
- Parent Portal will be the means of accessing all your student's important information, his/her progress/grades, missing assignments, and other concerns that might impact your student's performance or well-being. If you have not done so, please ensure that you sign up for the parent portal. (We highly encourage all guardians to ensure that you are signed up and have access to the parent portal THERE WILL BE NO PRINTED PROGRESS/REPORT CARDS)
