












TITLE I

What is it?

Title I, Part A (Title I) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESEA) provides financial assistance to local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools with high numbers or high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards.

How does it help students?

Schools in which children from low-income families make up at least 40 percent of enrollment are eligible to use Title I funds to operate schoolwide programs that serve all children in the school in order to raise the achievement of the lowest-achieving students.

OUR SCHOOL'S TITLE I PLAN

SMART GOAL 1

By June 2025, 60% of students in grade K-7 will meet or exceed their projected growth goal as measured by the iReady benchmark assessment in mathematics.

INTERIM GOALS

NOV. 15: By November 15, 2024, a minimum of 98% of all students will be administered the i-Ready diagnostic assessment to determine growth targets.

<u>FEB. 15</u>: By February 15, 2025, 25% of all students in grades K–7 will meet their individual projected growth goal.

APR. 15: By April 15, 2025, 50 % of all students in grades K-7 will meet their individual projected growth.

OUR SCHOOL'S TITLE I PLAN

SMART GOAL 2

By June 2025, 60% of students in grade K-7 will meet or exceed their projected growth goal as measured by the iReady benchmark assessment in ELA.

INTERIM GOALS

NOV. 15: By November 15, 2024, a minimum of 98% of all students will be administered the i–Ready diagnostic assessment to determine growth targets

FEB. 15: By February 15, 2025, 25% of all students in grades K-7 will meet their individual projected growth goal.

APR. 15: By April 15, 2025, 50 % of all students in grades K-7 will meet their individual projected growth.

OUR SCHOOL'S TITLE I PLAN

SMART GOAL 3

There will be a 2% decrease in the number of attendance referrals when compared with 2023–2024 data.

INTERIM GOALS

NOV 15: Chronically absent students have been identified and action plans have been developed.


Attendance reports will be reviewed at CPT's and

FEB 15: Conferences will be held with 80% of parents whose children have been identified as chronically absent. During parent–teacher conferences, the district goal regarding attendance will be reviewed along with individualized action plans.

APR 15: Through data review and analysis there will be a 1% decrease in the number of attendance/truancy for those students who are at risk when compared with 2022–2023 data.










